**ORDER**

The petitioner has filed the above writ petition to issue a writ of Mandamus, directing the 1<sup>st</sup> respondent to consider and pass appropriate orders on the representation dated 10.08.2017 within a time frame.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that though the petitioner has given a representation, dated 10.08.2017 for the issuance of Patta, the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent has not passed any order so far.

3. Mr.R.Rajeswaran, learned Special Government Pleader appearing for the respondents submitted that the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent may be directed to consider the petitioner's representation and pass orders in accordance with law, within a period of eight weeks.

4. Having regard to the submissions made by the learned counsel on either side, without expressing any opinion with regard to the merits of the case, I direct the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent to consider the petitioner's representation, dated 10.08.2017 and pass orders in accordance with law,

within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

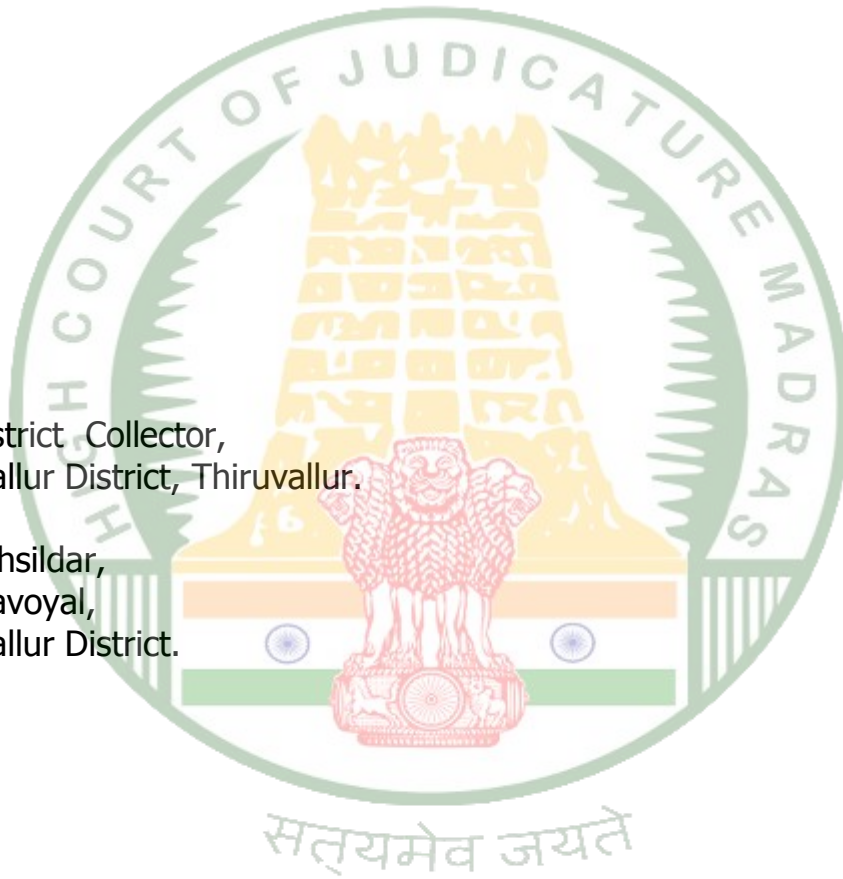
With this observation, the Writ Petition is disposed of. No costs.

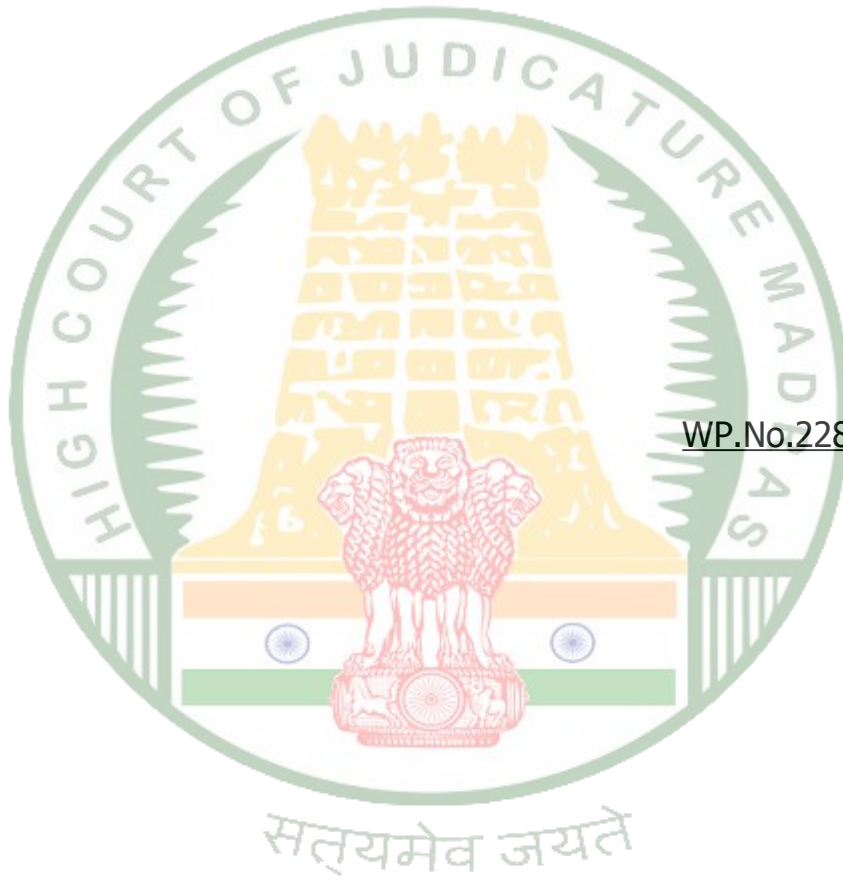
