Though this writ petition is filed challenging the Government Order in G.O.(Ms).No.697 Home (Transport 5) Department dated 05.08.2010 and consequential order of the second respondent dated 17.06.2015, Mr.K.Selvaraj, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that it would suffice, if the petitioner's representation is directed to be disposed of, by the respondents.

3. Under similar situations, this Court has also passed several orders directing the authorities to consider the representation of similarly situated persons and pass orders therein. Accordingly, this writ petition is disposed of, with a direction to the respondents to dispose of the petitioner's representation dated 05.11.2017 on merits and in accordance with law, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. No costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petitions are closed.
