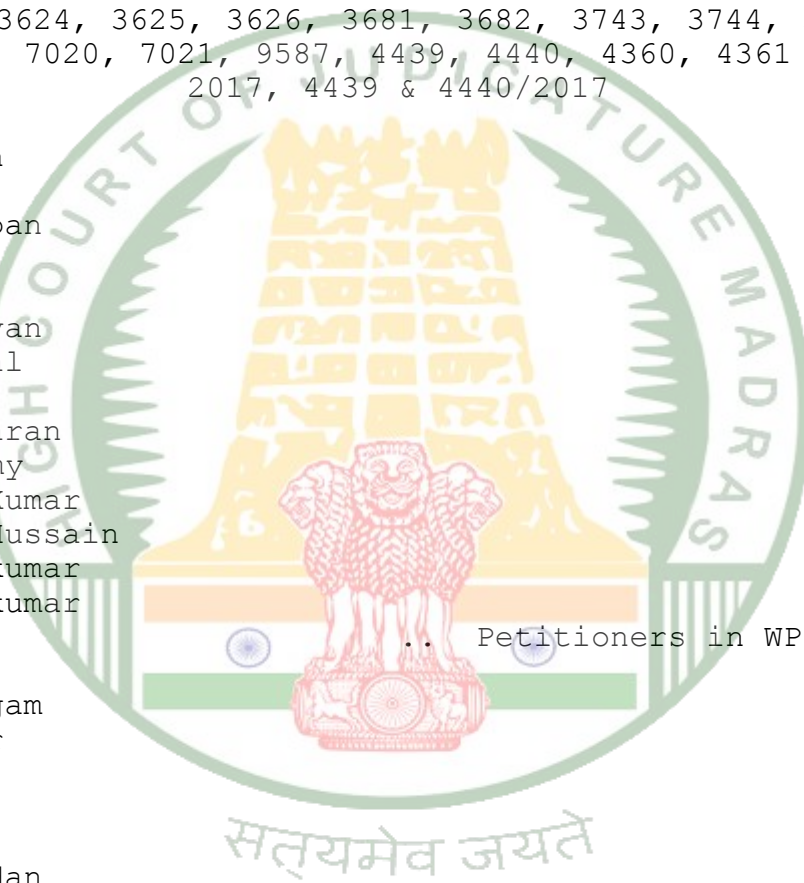

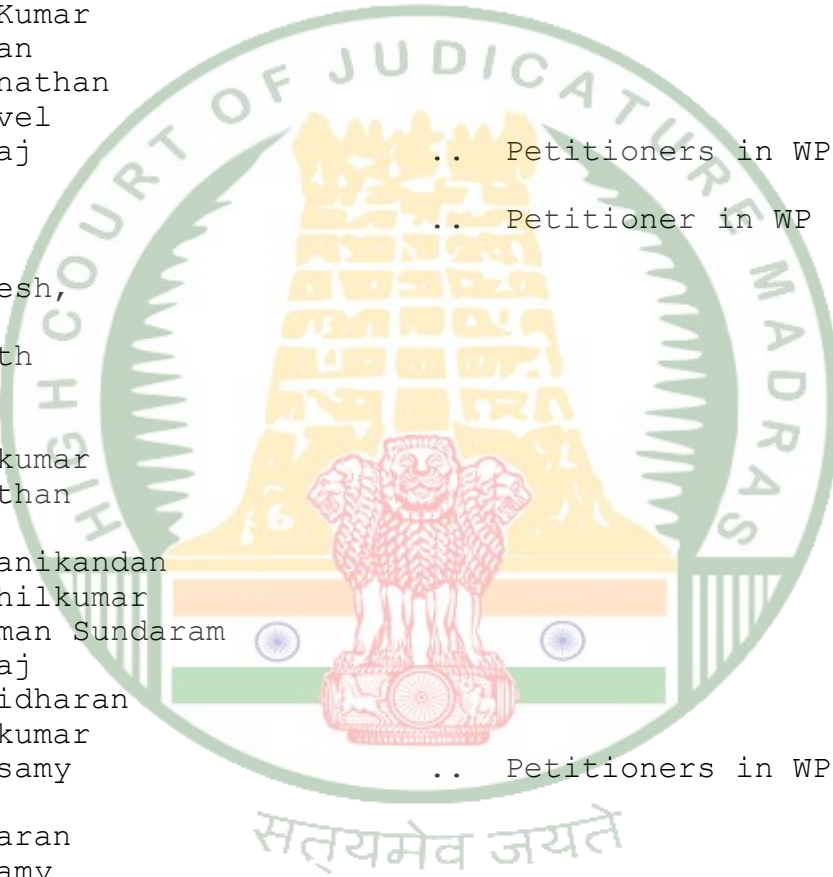

WPs 3332, 3333, 3334, 3696, 3697, 5783 & 4207/2017 are filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying for the issue of Writs of Certiorarified Mandamus, calling for the records in connection with the impugned order passed by the third respondent in Advertisement No.117 dated 23.1.2017 and to quash clause XI and XXIV of the impugned order and further direct the respondents to fix the age limit as per rule or in alternate to relax the upper age limit for Grade II PC, JW and Fireman-2016.

WPs 3252&3253/2017 are filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying for the issue of Writs of Certiorarified Mandamus, calling for the records pertaining to the Notification dated 23.1.2017 bearing Advertisement No.117 issued by the third respondent calling applications for

selecting candidates for the post of Grade II Police Constables, Jail Warders and Firemen through Common Exam-2017 and to quash the same and further to direct the respondents to fix the cutoff date for age limit as on date of Notification i.e., 23.1.2017.

WPs 3596&3597/2017 are filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying for the issue of Writs of Certiorarified Mandamus, calling for the records relating to the impugned recruitment notification issued by the second respondent dated 23.1.2017 vide Advertisement No.117 and quash the same in so far as age qualifications prescribed in Clause XI of the said notification being illegal, arbitrary and in violation of Articles 14 and 16 of the Constitution of India and consequently to direct the respondents to give age relaxation to the post of Constable Grade II/Grade II Jail Warders/Firemen-2017 and consider the candidatures of the petitioners.

WP 3649&4299/2017 is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying for the issuance of a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus, calling for the records pertaining to the Notification for the recruitment of Constables dated 23.1.2017 and in Advertisement No.117 Exam Notification No.1, General Examination, 2017 respectively and quash the same in so far as it relates to the upper age to the tune of 26 years for BCs, BCMs, MBCs and Seermarabinars and direct the BC, BCM, MBC and Seermarabinar persons who are of the 28 years to apply for the Post of II Grade Constables and other posts in consequence of Notification dated 23.1.2017 issued by the sixth respondent.

WP 6508/2017 is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying for the issuance of a Writ of Certiorari, calling for the records of the third respondent in the Uniformed Services Recruitment Notification dated 23.1.2017 and quash the same in so far as it is concerned with the age limit condition prescribed in Clause XI(3) of the impugned notification.

WP 8739/2017 is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying for the issuance of a Writ of Declaration, declaring the cutoff date for upper age limit for appointment to the post of Grade-II Police Constables (AR & TSP), Jail Warder and Fireman for the year 2016 as 1st July 2017 as null and void and further declare the cutoff date for upper age limit for appointment to the post of Grade-II Police Constables (AR & TSP), Jail Warder and Fireman for the year 2016 as 1st July 2016 as per the Special Rules for Tamil Nadu Subordinate Service and further direct the respondents to permit the petitioners to participate in the selection process.

WP 4273/2017 is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying for the issuance of a Writ of Certiorarified

Mandamus, calling for the records namely the Notification and quash the Notification vide Advertisement No.117, Exam Notification No.1, General Exam-2017 issued by the second respondent and issue a fresh Notification by incorporating the maximum age as per the 2011 Notification as Most Backward Category (MBC Community) as 28 years and Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribes (SC/ST Community) as 30 years there by making eligible for several aspirants waiting to join the Uniform Police Force pending since 2011 without any recruitment.
