Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that both the Civil Revision Petitions have become infructuous and he has also made an endorsement to that effect.

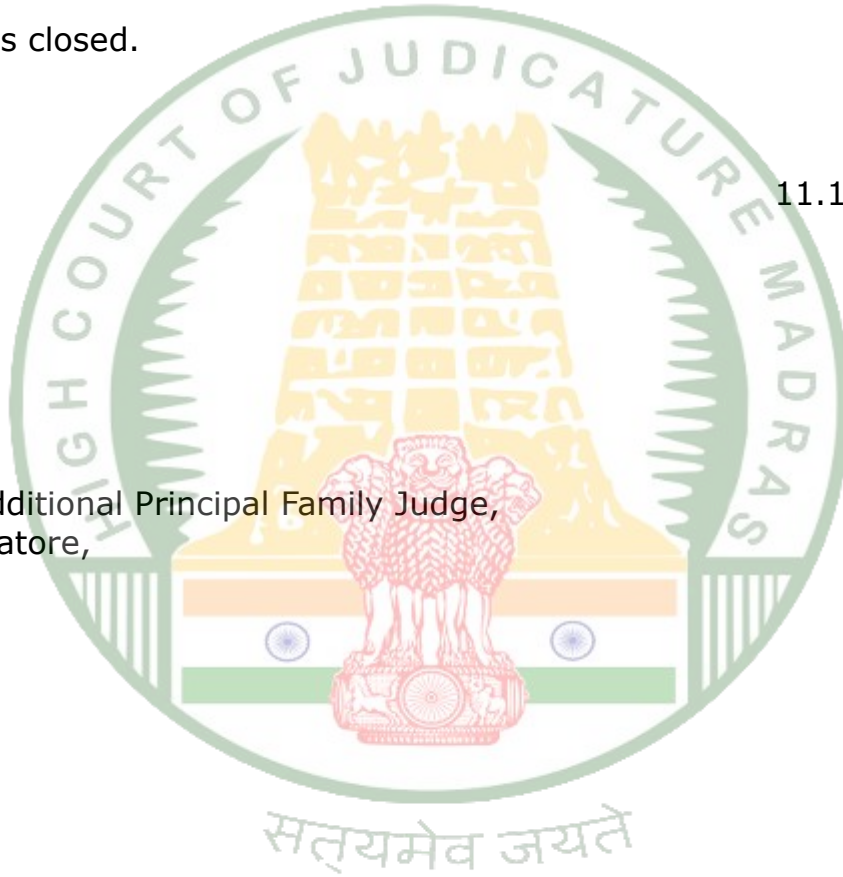

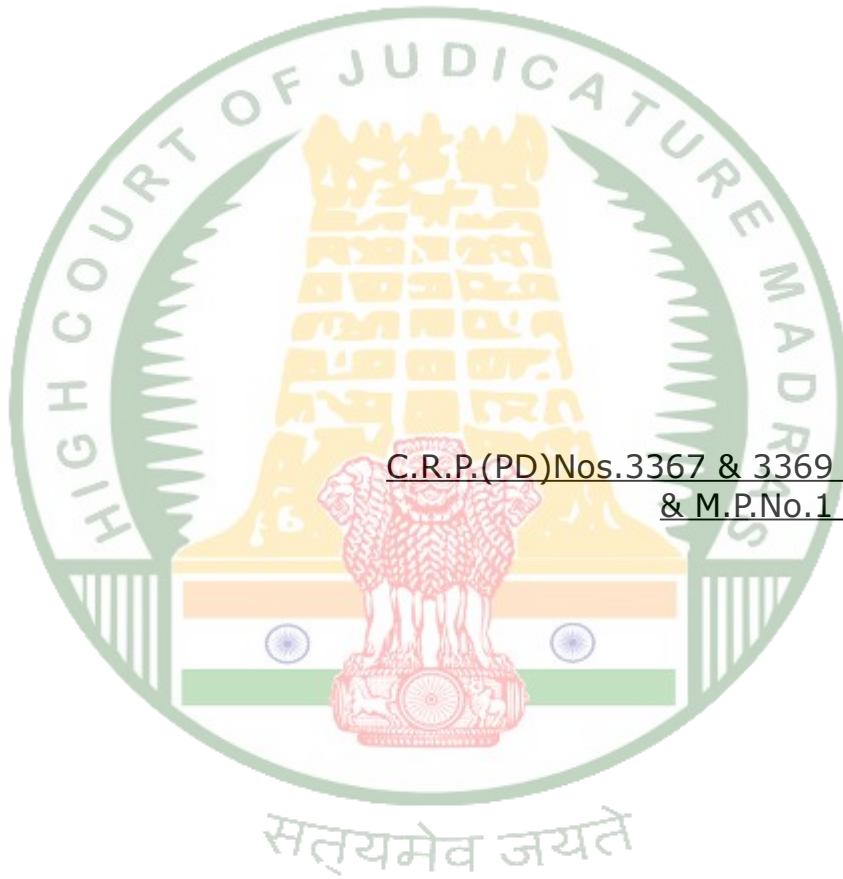
