Considering the reasons stated in the affidavit filed in support of this petition and after satisfying with the same, the claimants are permitted to withdraw 50% of the award amount lying to the credit of MCOP No.1983 of 2013 on the file of Motor Vehicles Accident Claims Tribunal, Coimbatore, as per the apportionment fixed by the Tribunal, with proportionate accrued interest and costs.

5. This petition is ordered accordingly.
