O R D E R

After arguing the matter for considerable length of time and when this Court expressed the opinion that the writ petitioner was discharged from duty on, expiry of the tenure and the post in Home Guards, will not confer any right, the learned counsel appearing for the writ petitioner made a submission that there is a Provision for Appeal. It is left open to the writ petitioner to prefer an Appeal to the higher authorities against the order of discharge. Under these circumstances, the learned counsel requested the Court to grant permission to withdraw the writ petition. Accordingly, the learned counsel is permitted to withdraw the writ petition.

Accordingly, the writ petition stands dismissed as withdrawn. However, there shall be no order as to costs. Consequently, connected Miscellaneous Petition is also dismissed.
