This Court, considering the limited prayer made by the petitioner, taking note of the proposal made by the third respondent on 08.04.2017 and without going into the merits of the matter, directs the respondents 1 and 2 to consider and dispose of the petitioner's representation dated 08.05.2017 on the basis of the proposal made by the third respondent in Na.Ka.No.1666/A5/2017 dated 08.04.2017 and pass orders on merits and in accordance with law within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
