2 The Court heard the submissions of Mr.K.Soundararajan, learned Standing counsel accepting notice on behalf of the respondents 1 and 2.

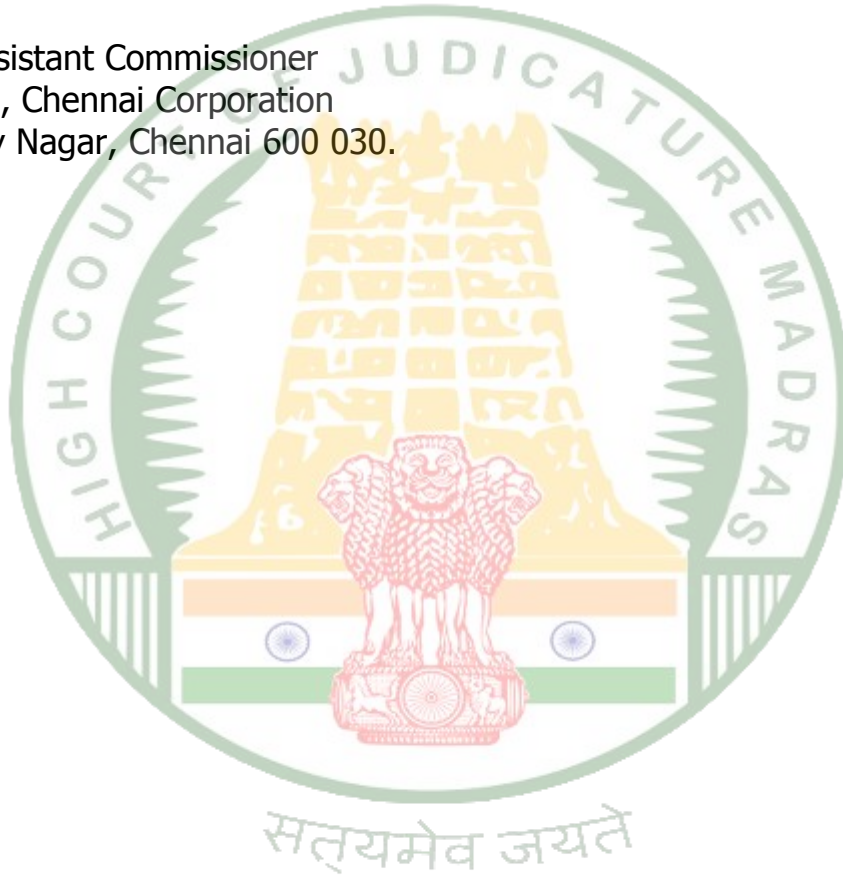

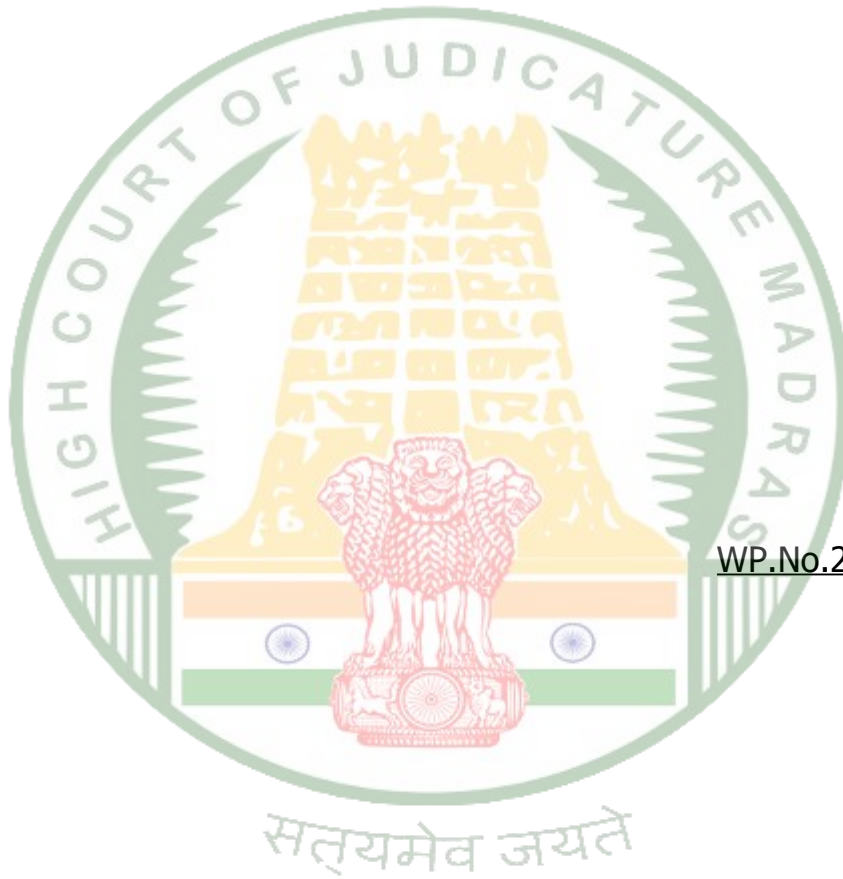
