This petition has been filed by the Petitioners seeking to declare the first petitioner, Saranya, as major and discharge her mother, namely, the second petitioner, as her guardian and to permit the first petitioner to proceed with the above Appeal, in her individual capacity, as major, along with the second petitioner.

2. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners.

It is claimed that the date of birth of the first petitioner is 03.06.1997, which is supported by the Birth Certificate, issued by the Government of Tamil Nadu, under Sections 12/17 of the Registration of Births and Death Act, 1969 and Rule 8 of the Tamil Nadu Registration of Births and Death Rules, 2000.

4. Hence, the first petitioner, Saranya, is declared as major and consequently, her mother, namely, Lakshmi (the second petitioner), is discharged from the guardianship of the first petitioner and permission is hereby given to the first petitioner to proceed with the above Appeal, in her individual capacity, as major, along with the second petitioner.

5. This CMP is ordered accordingly.
