Now after a lapse of 13 years, such a prayer cannot be considered by this Court and the learned counsel for the writ petitioner is also unable to apprise this Court with regard to the present status of the writ petitioner. Therefore this Court is not inclined to consider the grounds raised in this writ petition and accordingly the same is dismissed. No costs.
