ORDER

Mr.S.N.Parthasarathi, learned Government Advocate takes notice for the respondent. By consent, the main writ petition is taken up for disposal at the admission stage itself.

1. The petitioner has filed the above writ petition to issue a writ of mandamus directing the respondent to consider and dispose of his representation dated 4.5.2017, within a time frame.

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3. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that the respondent has not passed any order on the petitioner's representation dated 04.05.2017 so far.

4. Mr.S.N.Parthasarathi, learned Government Advocate appearing for the respondent submitted that the respondent may be directed to consider the petitioner's representation dated 04.05.2017, and pass orders in accordance with law, within a period of eight weeks.

5. Having regard to the submissions made by the learned counsel on either side, without expressing any opinion with regard to the merits of the case, I direct the respondent to consider the petitioner's representation dated 04.05.2017 and pass orders in accordance with law, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

With this observation, the writ petition is disposed of. No costs. Connected miscellaneous petition is closed.

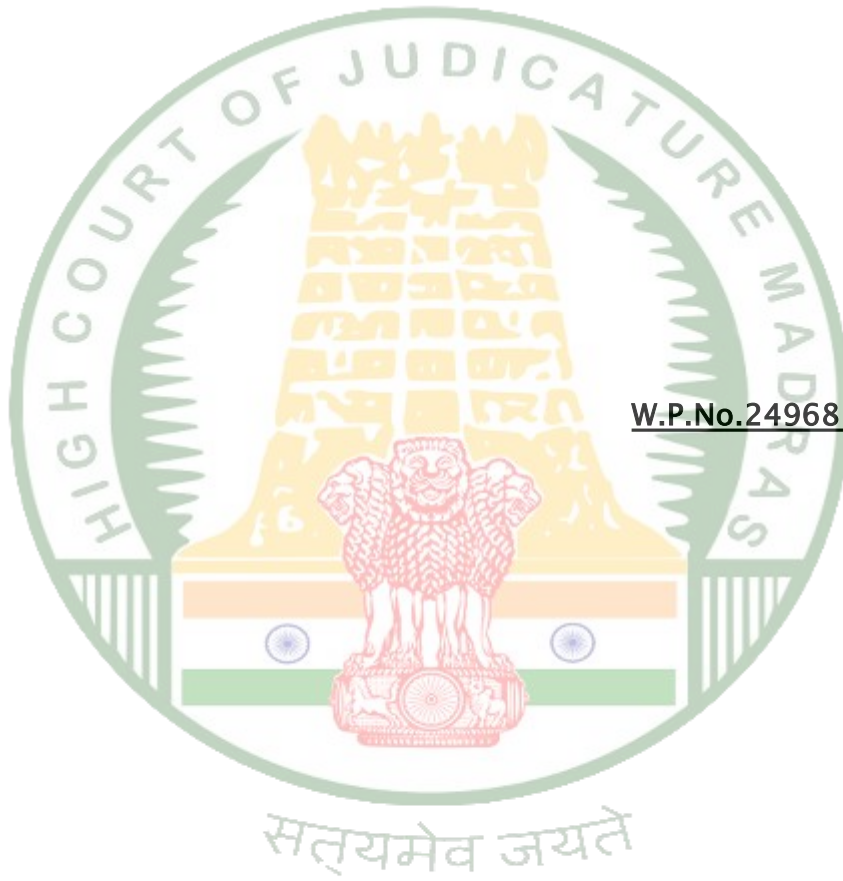
