Petition praying that in the circumstances stated therein and in the Memorandum of Grounds in Criminal APPEAL No.793 OF 2017 on the file of the High Court, the High Court will be pleased to suspend the sentence imposed on the petitioner by the learned II Additional District and Sessions Judge, CBI Cases, Coimbatore made in C.C.No.1 of 2012 dated 08.12.2017 and enlarge the petitioner on bail pending disposal of the above CRL.A.NO.793/2017.

Order : This petition coming on for orders upon perusing the petition and the Memorandum of Grounds in Crl.A.No.793 of 2017 on the file of the High Court and upon hearing the arguments of M/S.MUTHAPPAN, Advocate for the petitioner and of MR. K.SRINIVASAN, SPECIAL PUBLIC PROSECUTOR FOR CBI CASES, on behalf of the Respondent the court made the following order:-

This petition has been filed to suspend the sentence of imprisonment imposed in the judgment dated 08.12.2017 made in C.C.No.1 of 2012 on the file of the II Additional District and Sessions Judge, CBI Cases, Coimbatore and enlarge the petitioner on bail, convicted and sentenced the petitioner as under:

Conviction under Section	Sentence
Section 120(b) r/w.409, 465, 467, 468, 471 477(a) and Section 13(2) r/w.13(i) (c)(d) of Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988	Three years rigorous imprisonment and to pay a fine of Rs.1,000/-.

2. Challenging the same, the present appeal has been filed along with this petition for suspension of sentence.

3. Taking into consideration of the submission of the learned counsels appearing on both sides, since there are some arguable points available in the appeal, I am inclined to pass the following orders: The substantive sentence imposed against the petitioner alone is suspended on condition that

i) the petitioner shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees one lakh only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned II Additional District and Sessions Judge, CBI Cases, Coimbatore, within the said period of three weeks from today and

ii) the petitioner shall appear before the above said Court on the first working day of every English calendar month at 10.30 a.m, until further orders.
