2. The petitioner has filed the above Writ Petition to issue a writ of mandamus directing the respondent to consider his representation dated 14.06.2017 and grant permission for conducting the Music Orchestra on 18.6.2017 in the temple festival in accordance with law.

2.It is the case of the petitioner that in spite of the representation being given to the respondent on 14.06.2017 for conducting Music Orchestra in the Temple on 18.06.2017, the respondent has not passed orders till today.

3.A Division Bench of this Court in W.P.(MD).No.3773 of 2017, by order dated 03.03.2017, in similar circumstances, directed the respondent to consider the representation of the petitioner therein and dispose of the same.

4.Following the order passed by the Division Bench, I direct the respondent to consider the petitioner's representation dated 14.06.2017 and pass orders, on merits and in accordance with law, on or before 17.06.2017.

With this observation, the Writ Petition is disposed of.
