ORDER

(Order of the Court was made by the Hon'ble Chief
Justice)

We are informed that there is no Waqf Board. The Waqf
Board is due to be constituted within a month. A full time
Chief Executive Officer can be appointed from a panel of
two names suggested by the Waqf Board. Since Waqf Board

is likely to be constituted within one month, the writ petition is premature. The writ petition may be withdrawn with liberty to file a fresh writ petition after two months if no full time Chief Executive Officer is appointed in the meanwhile.

2. The writ petition is disposed of as withdrawn. No costs.

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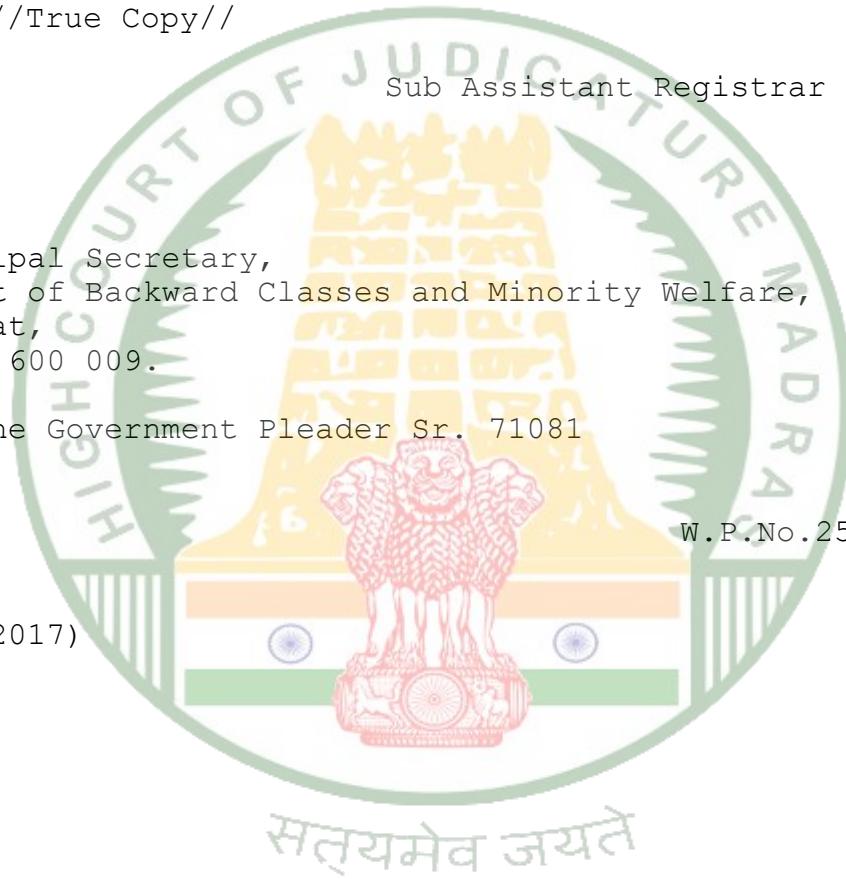
