O R D E R

The writ petition is filed seeking mandamus, forbearing the respondents from interfering with the peaceful possession and enjoyment of the property No.4, Mount Poonamallee Road, Chennai.

4.Accordingly, the writ petition is dismissed for non-prosecution. However, there shall be no order as to costs.
