ORDER

(Order of the Court was made by the Hon'ble Chief Justice)

This writ petition has been filed seeking directions on the concerned respondents not to create any thoroughfare in between the schools of the fifth and sixth respondents.

2. In the entire writ petition, the petitioners have not adverted to the violation of any law, rule or regulation in creating a thoroughfare. If the land is held by the concerned educational institutions and if there is no contravention of any law, it is not for the residents to decide how many gates, how many entry points the educational institution should have. There apparently is no public interest involved and the petitioners have not been able to substantiate their contention that the creation of an extra entrance and/or thoroughfare will aggravate the traffic situation in the locality.

The writ petition is, thus, dismissed. No costs. Consequently, W.M.P.No.26932 of 2017 is closed.

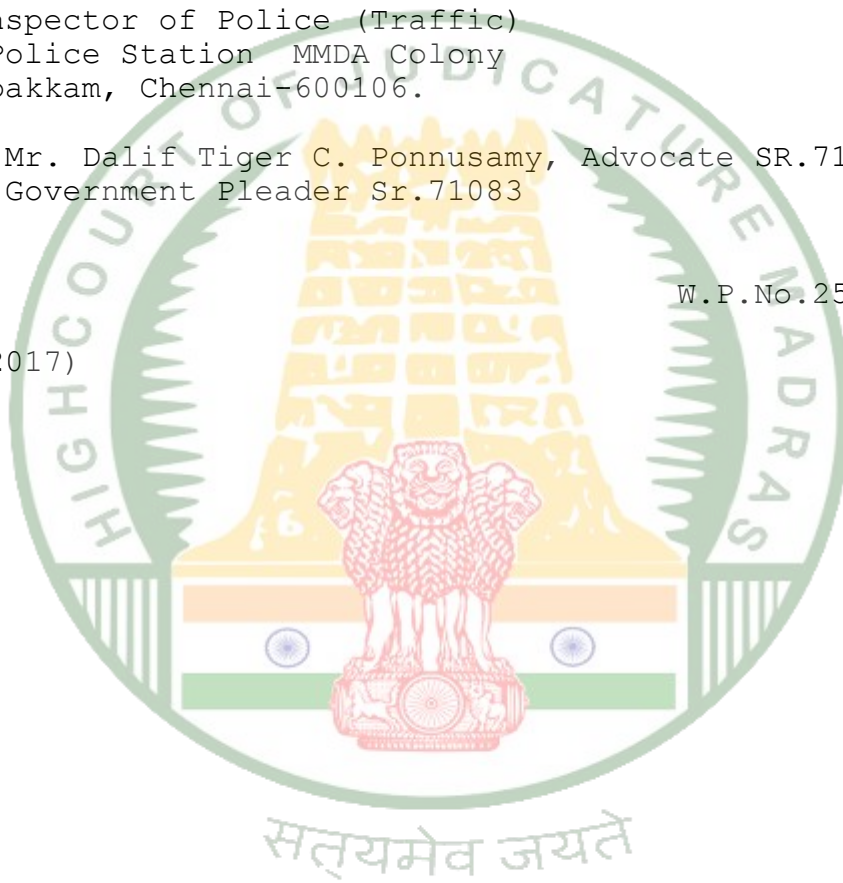
