COMMON ORDER

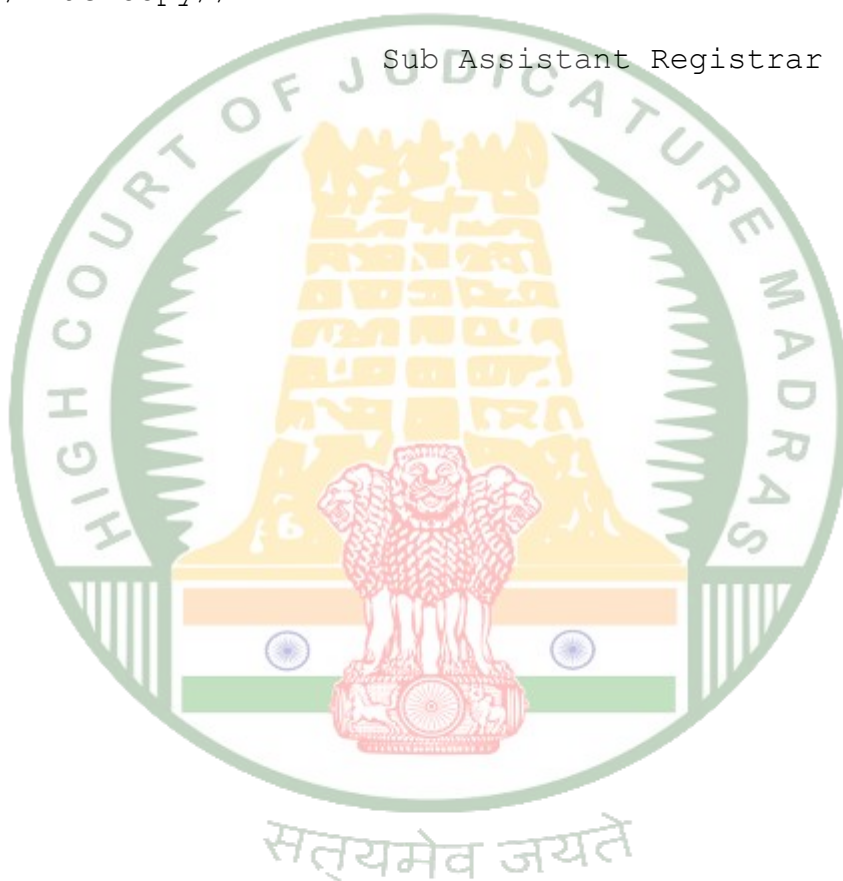
Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner represents

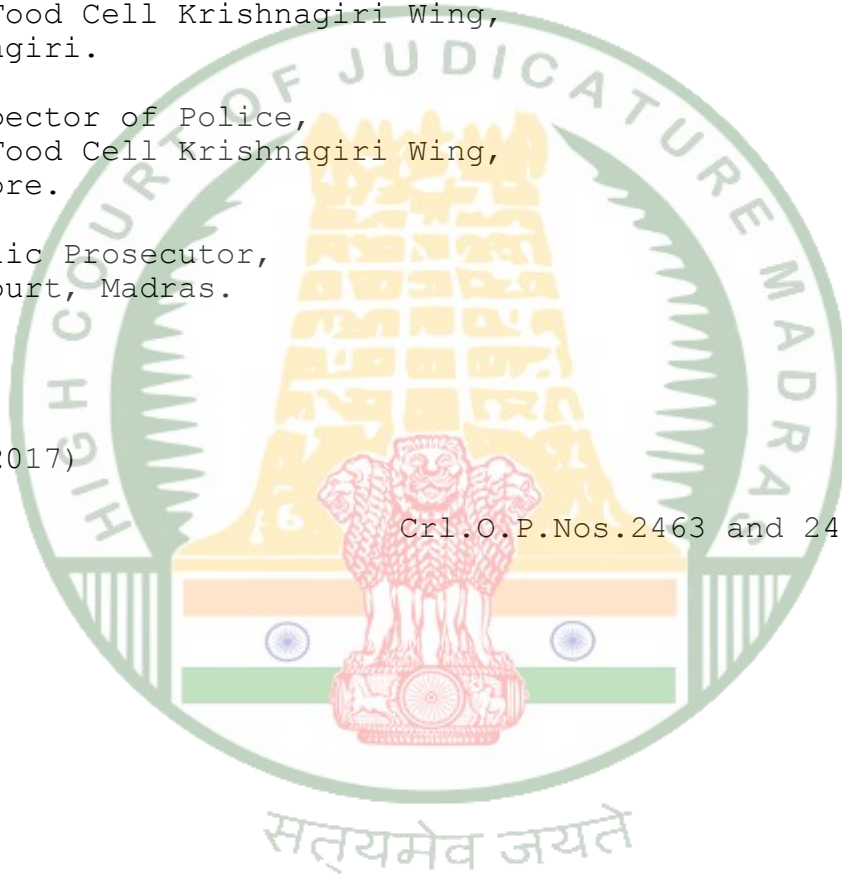
