ORDER

The petitioner has come to this Court challenging the order passed by the Superintendent of Police, Kancheepuram District dismissing the petitioner from service on the ground that he demanded and accepted a bribe of Rs.3,000/-.

In my considered opinion, as the petitioner has got an effective appeal remedy before the appellate authority and the further appeal before the Director General of Police as well a further review petition before the Government, he should exhaust all the statutory remedies, without which he cannot come to this Court by filing the present writ petition. Hence, without going into the merits of the matter, the writ petition is dismissed

with liberty to the petitioner to approach the appellate authority within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. Consequently, W.M.P.No.27579 of 2017 is also dismissed. No costs.

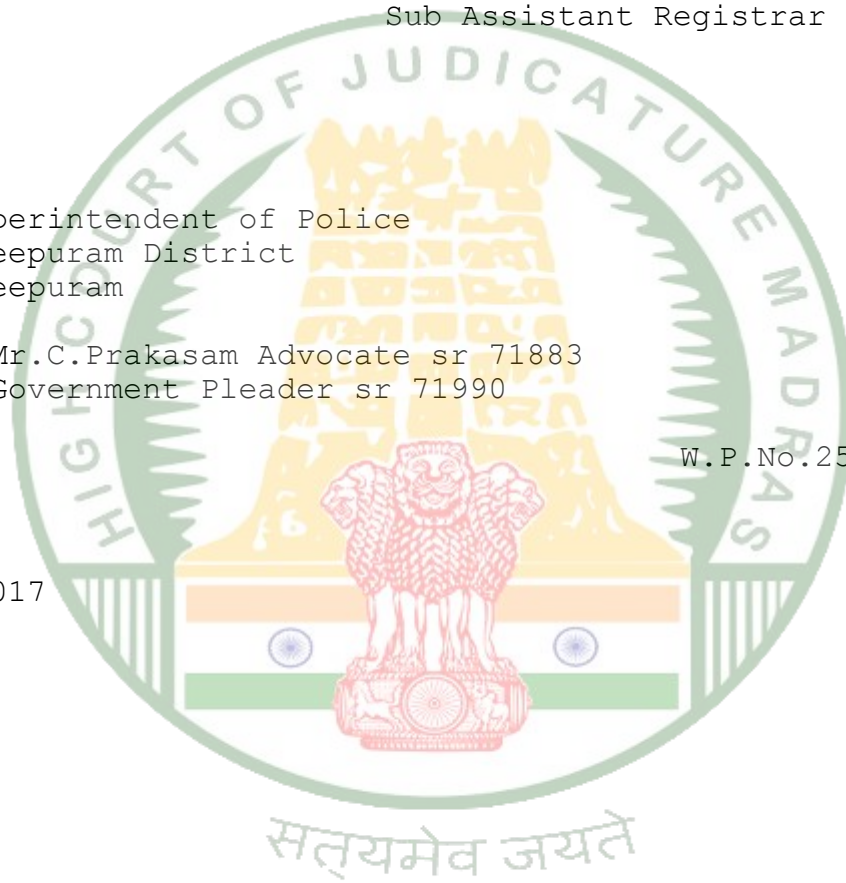
