2. Today, when the matter is taken up for hearing, there is no representation for the petitioner.

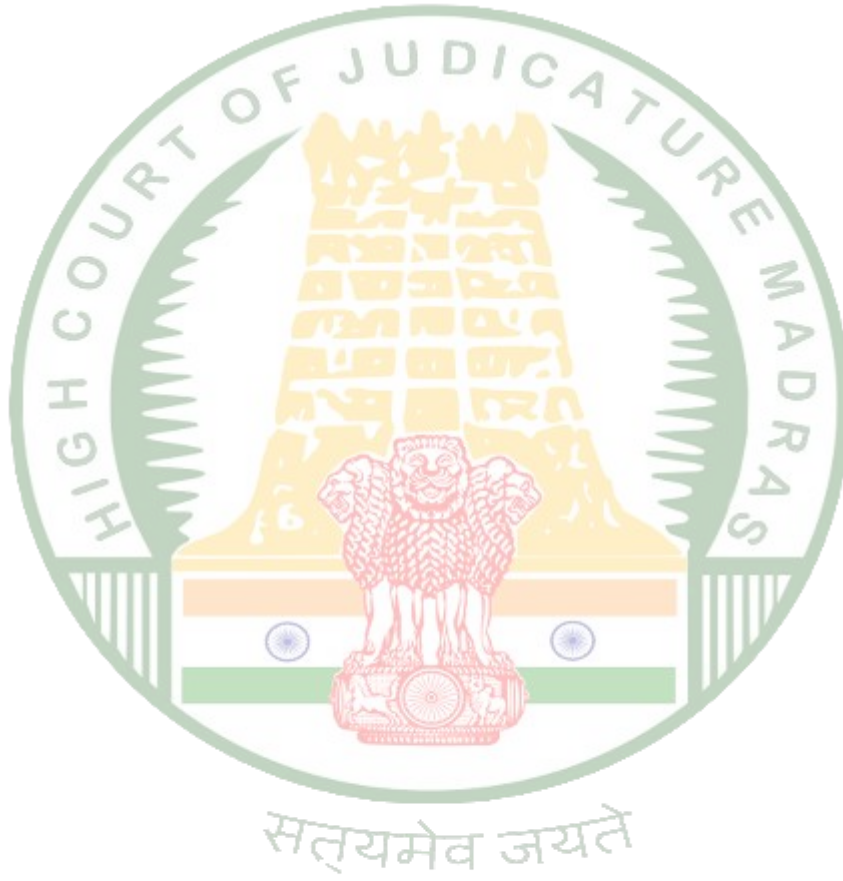
