Writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of a Certiorarified Mandamus to call for the records of the third and fourth respondents respectively in relation to the proceedings issued in Na.Ka.No.7/73438/2000 dated 12.04.2001 and in P.M.(W9) 18573/2004 dated 31.03.2004 issued by the third respondent and in AG(A&E)/PENSION PO9/5/A-129-1454/R.T.D./2004-2005 dated 24.03.2005 issued by the fourth respondent and quash the same and issue a consequential direction to the respondents to restore the pay of the petitioner at Rs.1760/- in the scale of pay of Rs.1640-2900 with effect from 1.06.88 and fix the petitioner's pay at Rs.8275/- in the scale of

pay of Rs.8000-13500/- as on 1.1.1996 and fix last drawn pay on said basis on 31.3.2004 and fix the pension and arrears of pension and to grant the amount of gratuity of Rs.2,12,273/- with interest at 18% per annum to the petitioner.

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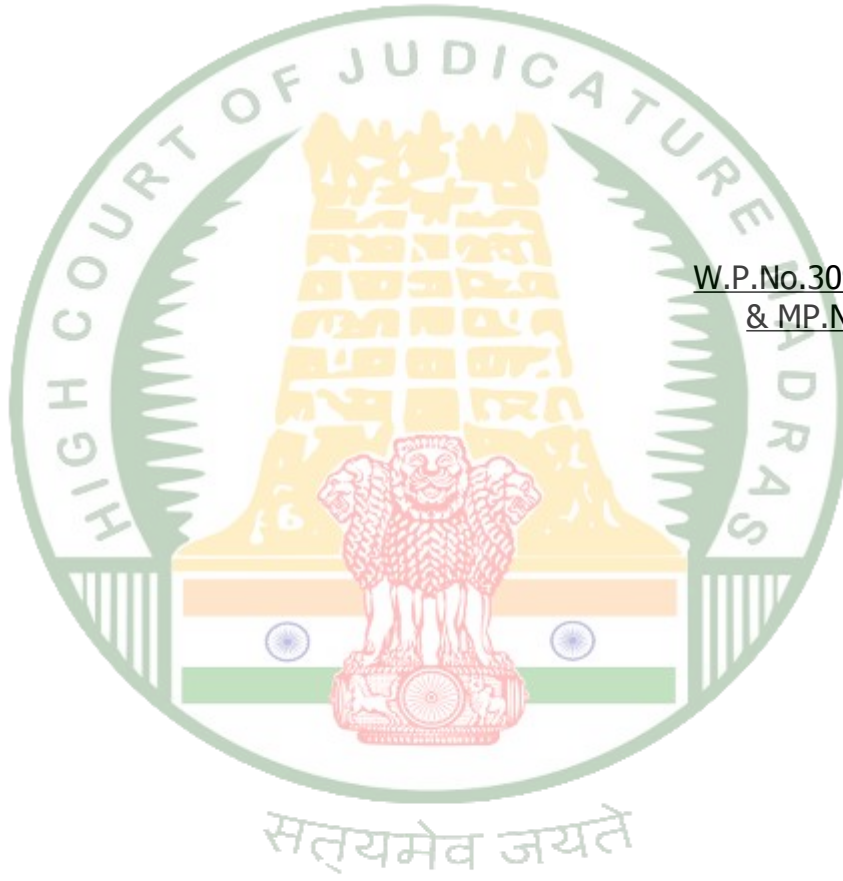
