2. Recording the same, permission is granted. Accordingly, the Writ Petition is dismissed as withdrawn. No costs.

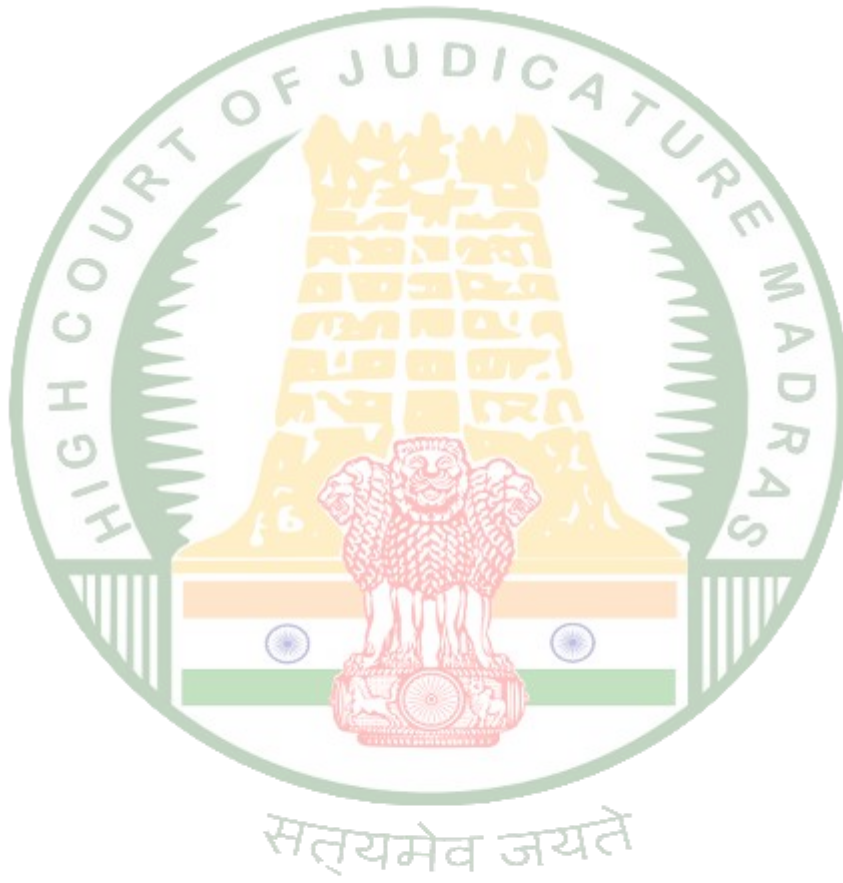
