Unfortunately, the petitioner, who claims to be the President of the Association, is not even aware of what is the date of retirement of the horticulture workers, in the light of the law laid down by this Court. The learned Government Advocate for the respondents also submitted that the Government had already issued a Government Order, following the judgment passed by this Court, that the

horticulture workers falling under Basic Service should be allowed to retire at the age of 60 years. Therefore, the writ petition filed without any basis is dismissed. No costs.
