**Prayer :**

Writ petition No.3613 of 2016 filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, for issuance of a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus, to call for the records relating to the impugned fee structure dated 03.11.2014 issued by the 4<sup>th</sup> respondent for BHMS Course quash the same as illegal and consequently direct the 4<sup>th</sup> respondent to re-frame the fees structure for the BHMS Course in accordance with the fee structure issued by the Government of Tamil Nadu for BHMS Course.
