When the writ petitions are taken up for hearing, the learned Additional Advocate General appearing for the petitioner, on instructions, invites the attention of this Court to Letter No.22889/E-5/2005-36, dated 23.10.2017 from the Deputy Secretary to Government and submits that the proposal for regularization of services of Tvl.K.Anbalagan and two others are under active consideration by the Government in consultation with the Advisory departments. In this regard, a request has been made seeking extension of time for implementation of order of the Labour Court, Salem in I.D.No.198 of 1999 dated 18.09.2000.

3. Heard the learned counsel for the 1st respondent and perused the documents available on record.

Considering the submission of the learned Additional Advocate General appearing for the petitioner and placing on record the Letter No.22889/E-5/2005-36 dated 23.10.2017 from Deputy Secretary to Government, this Court, hereby grants four weeks time to the petitioner for implementation of the order dated 18.09.2000 in I.D.No.198 of 1999 passed by the Labour Court and by granting four weeks time, these Writ Petitions are dismissed. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petitions are closed. No costs.

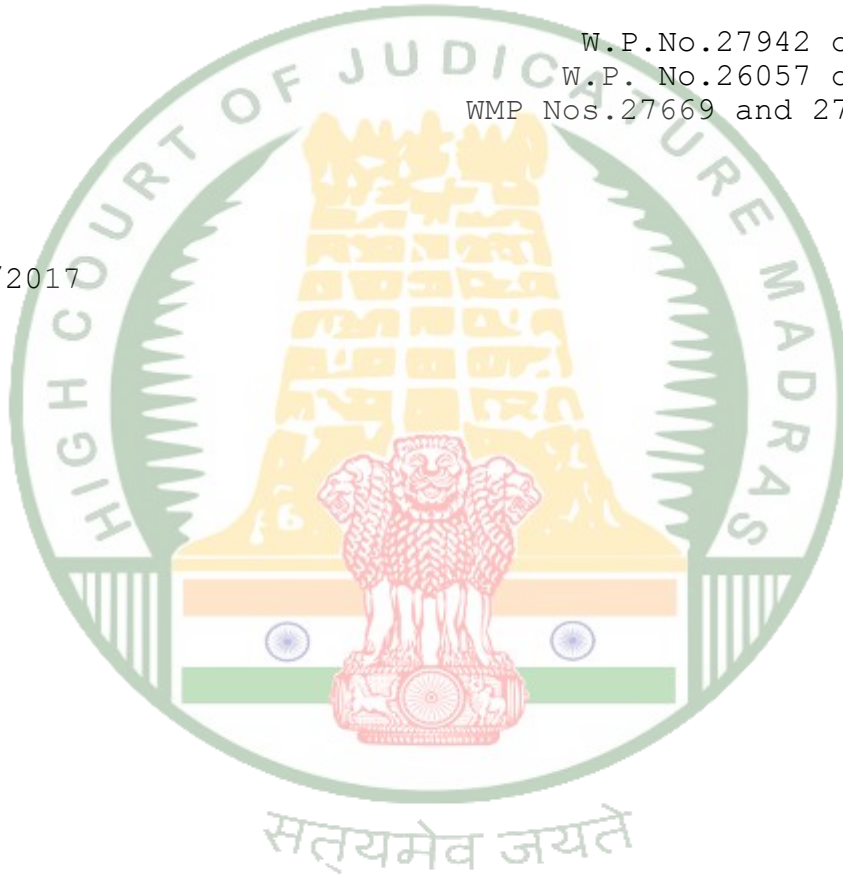
