Prayer: These writ appeals have been filed under clause 15 of the Letter Patent against the order passed by the learned Single Judge of this Court in M.P.Nos.1 and 2 of 2013 in W.P.No.19915 of 2013 dated 23.07.2013.

Prayer in M.P. 1 /13 in W.P. 19915 of 2013:

To restrain the respondents by an order of injunction from filling up the post of Assistant Professor in Management.

Prayer in M.P. 2/13 in W.P.19915/13:

To direct the respondents 2 and 3 to permit the petitioner to work in the respondent University, as Assistant Professor as interim measure.

Prayer in W.P. 19915 of 2013:

Writ petition filed under Article 226 of the constitution of India to issue a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus calling for the records pertaining to the proceedings No IMU/EST/HQ/STAFF/01/FACUL/ MGT/AP012/2012/12-11 dated 14.6.2013 issued by the 3rd respondent, quash the same and direct the respondents to permit the petitioner to join duty as Assistant Professor in Management in the respondent University as per the original proceedings No. IMU/EST/HQ/STAFF/01/FACUL/MGT/AP012/2012 dated 27.12.2012

COMMON JUDGMENT
