2.Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner as well as the learned counsel for the second respondent and the learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the first respondent.

3.The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that pending investigation in Cr.No.2031 of 2017 on the file of the first respondent, the second respondent/de-facto complainant and the petitioner have amicably settled the dispute among themselves. 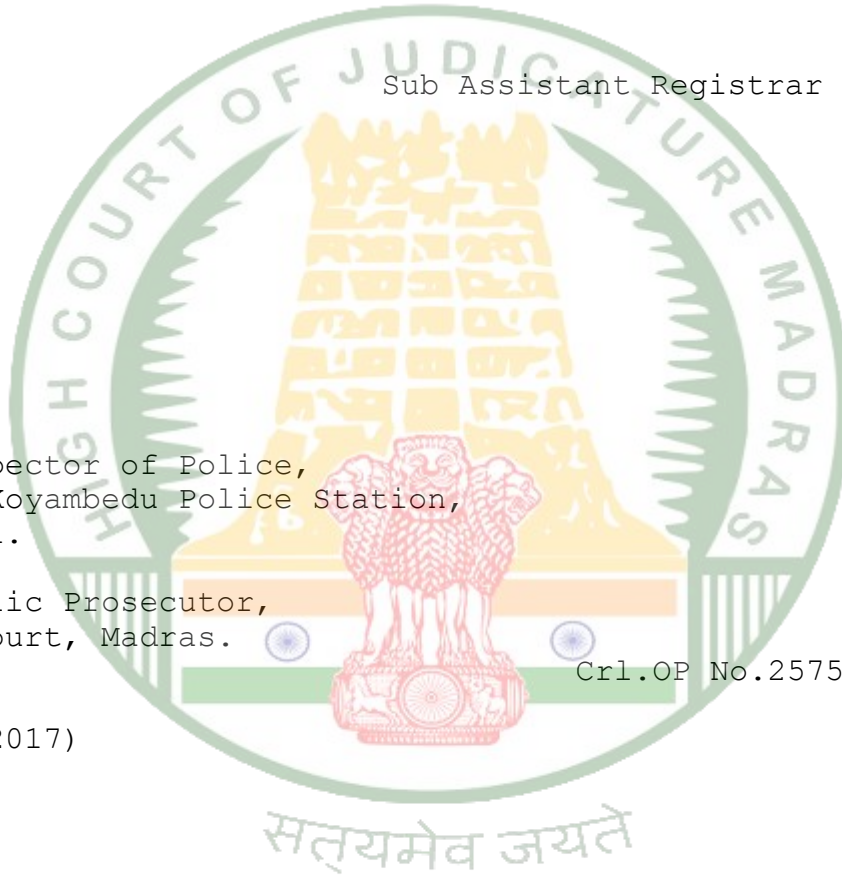
