ORDER

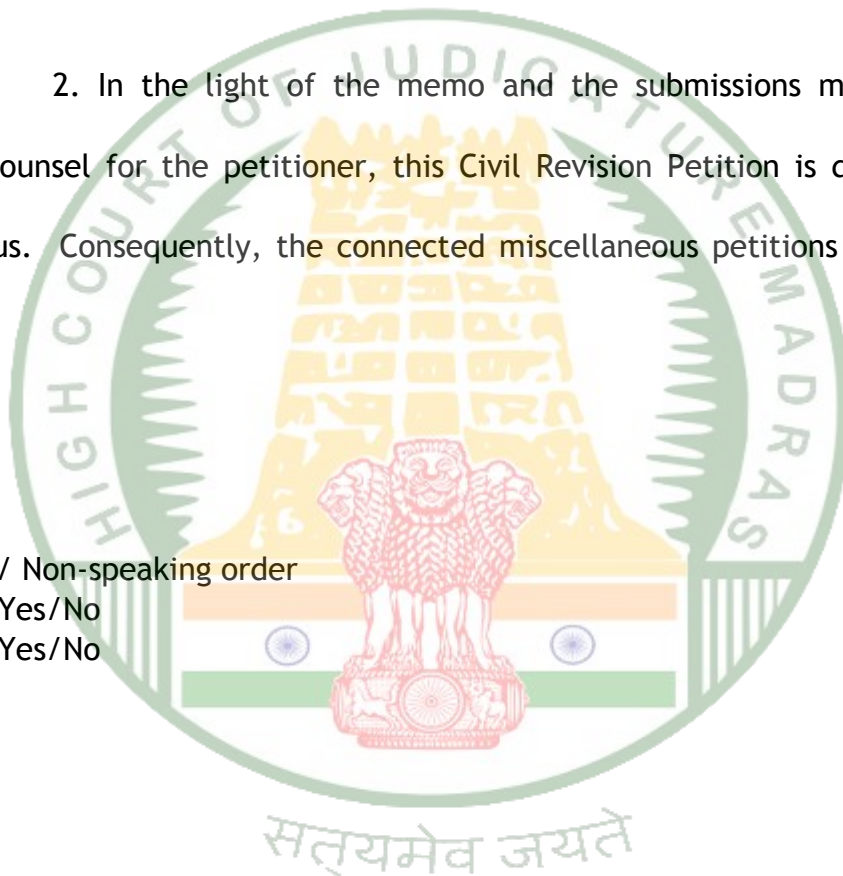
The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that pending the Civil Revision Petition, Judgment and Decree has been passed by the trial
