The petitioner challenges the order of suspension dated 11.01.2017, by which, the petitioner has been placed under suspension, pending enquiry into the grave charges.

2.Without going into the merits of the matter or the gravity of the charges against the petitioner, I am of the considered opinion that a challenge to an order of suspension, that too of a person in uniformed services pending enquiry into serious charges cannot be interfered with by this Court. However, it will be open to the petitioner to seek review of the order of suspension, since nearly four months have elapsed from the date of suspension. It is for the authorities to consider such request, if any, made by the petitioner.

3.The writ petition is disposed of with the above observations. No costs. Consequently, the connected miscellaneous petition is also closed.

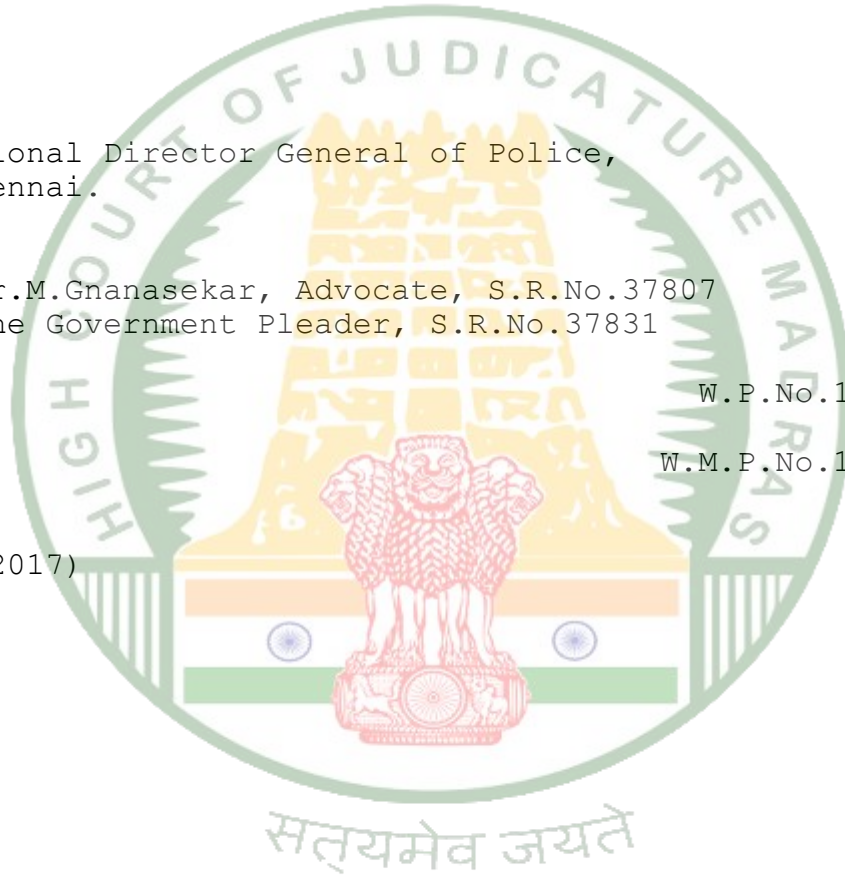
