The petitioner has filed the above Writ Petition to issue a writ of mandamus directing the respondent to give permission to conduct a cultural program (Adalum Padalum) schedule to be held on 06.08.2017 at "Shri Periya Andavan Temple" at Pudur, Mukkanur Post, Natrampalli Taluk, Vellore District, by considering his representation dated 29.07.2017.

2.It is the case of the petitioner that in spite of the representation being given to the respondent on 29.07.2017 for conducting cultural programme in the Temple on 06.08.2017, the respondent has not passed orders till today.

3.A Division Bench of this Court in W.P.(MD).No.3773 of 2017 by order dated 03.03.2017 in similar circumstances directed the respondent to consider the petitioner's representation and dispose of the same.

4.Following the order passed by the Division Bench, I direct the respondent to consider the petitioner's representation dated 29.07.2017. and pass orders, on merits and in accordance with law, on or before 05.08.2017.

With this observation, the Writ Petition is disposed of. No costs.
