Appeal No.250/2017 on the file of the High Court and upon hearing the arguments of M/S.N.KUMANAN, Advocate for the petitioner and of MR.P.LOVINDA RAJAN ADDL.PUBLIC PROSECUTOR, on behalf of the Respondent the court made the following order:-

This Miscellaneous Petition is taken up by the appellant in the appeal who has been convicted by the Mahila Court, Chennai in S.C. No.13 of 2014 by judgment dated 25.11.2016, for an offence under Section 302, IPC. He was sentenced to undergo imprisonment for life.

2 Since the conviction and sentence have been imposed on the appellant only after the offence having been established by a full fledged trial, we do not find this to be an appropriate case where sentence should be suspended. Hence, we see no justifiable reason to entertain the request of the petitioner for suspension of sentence.

Accordingly, this Miscellaneous Petition stands dismissed.
