The learned Senior Counsel, therefore, seeks liberty to challenge the order, dated 19 September, 2016, in Review Application Nos.27 to 48 of 2015.

2. Since the Review Applications were allowed, pending disposal of these Writ Petitions, it is open to the petitioners to challenge the subsequent order, dated 19.09.2016, if they are so advised.

3. We dismiss the Writ Petitions with liberty. No costs. Consequently, connected Miscellaneous Petitions are closed.

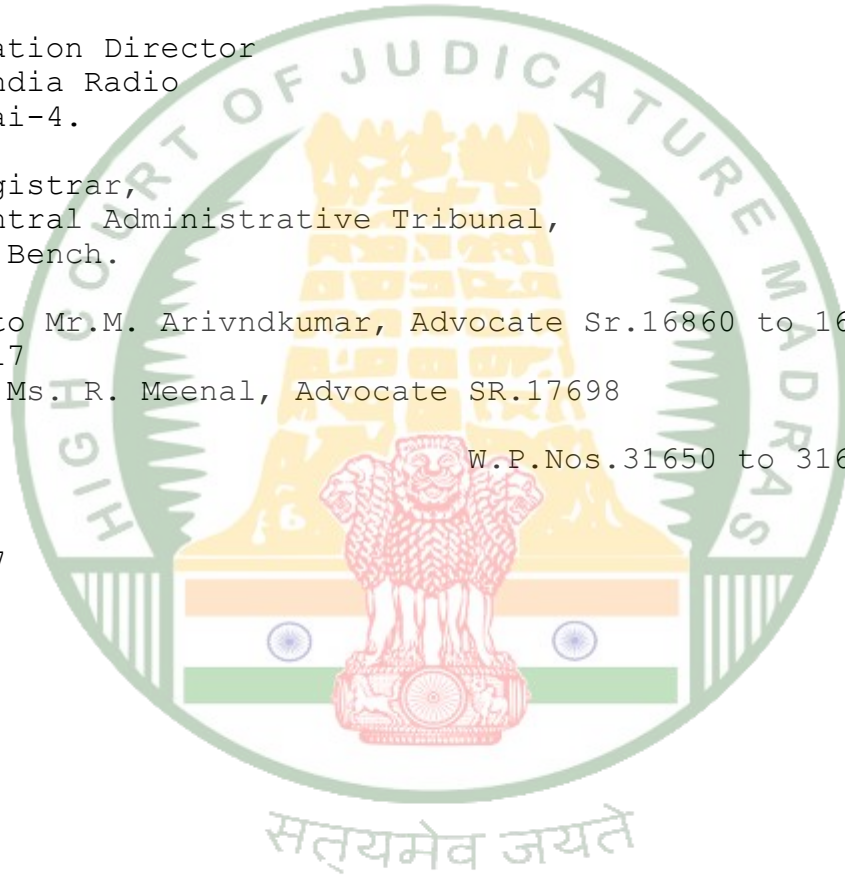
