JUDGMENT

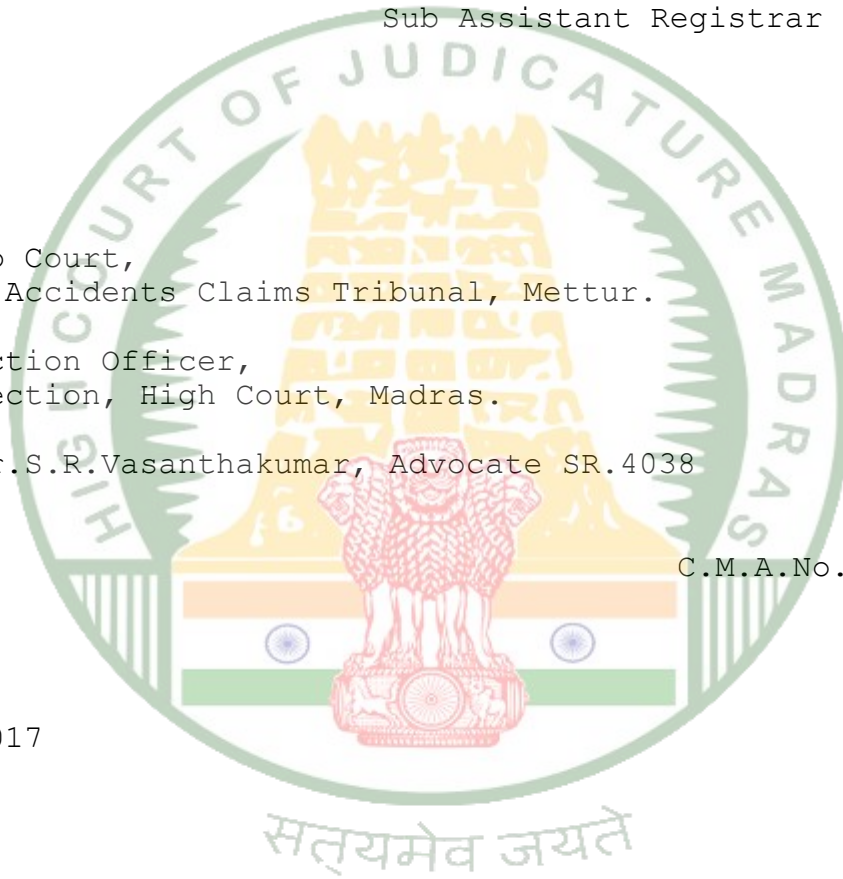
