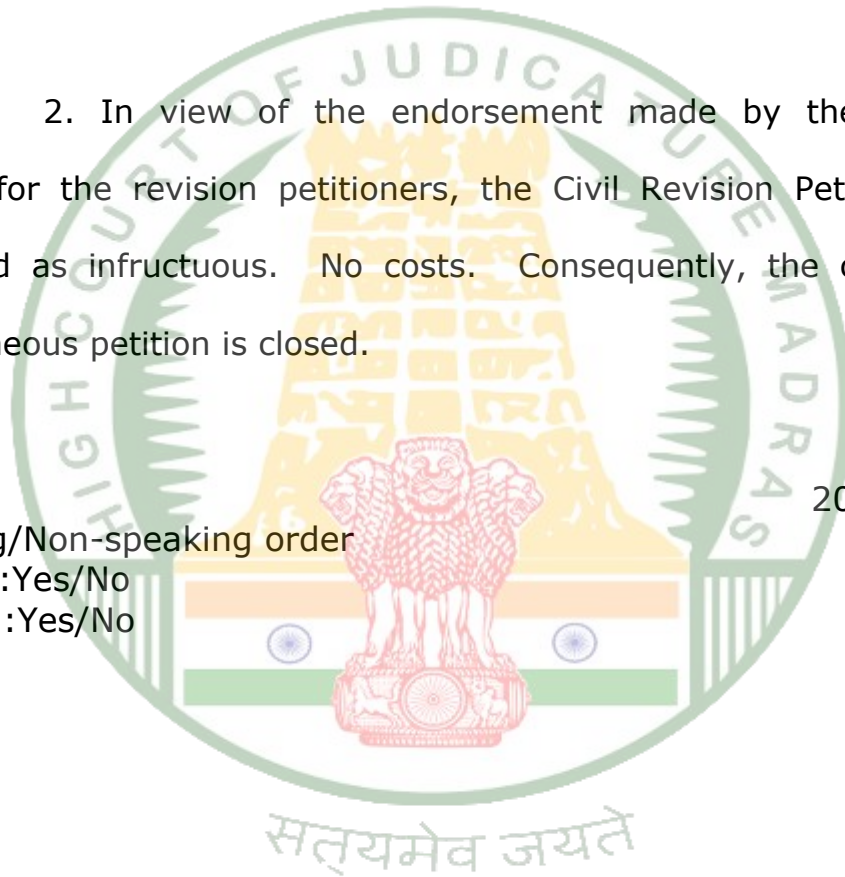
COMMON ORDER
