2.Today, when the Writ Petition was taken up for hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that pursuant to the interim order of this Court dated 29.04.2004, stating that 'there will be an order to the limited extent of not allowing the drainage water to get stagnated near the petitioner's

theatre', nothing further survives for adjudication in this Writ Petition.

3. Recording the said submission, the Writ Petition is dismissed as having become infructuous. No costs. Consequently, connected W.P.M.P.No.12679 of 2004 is closed.

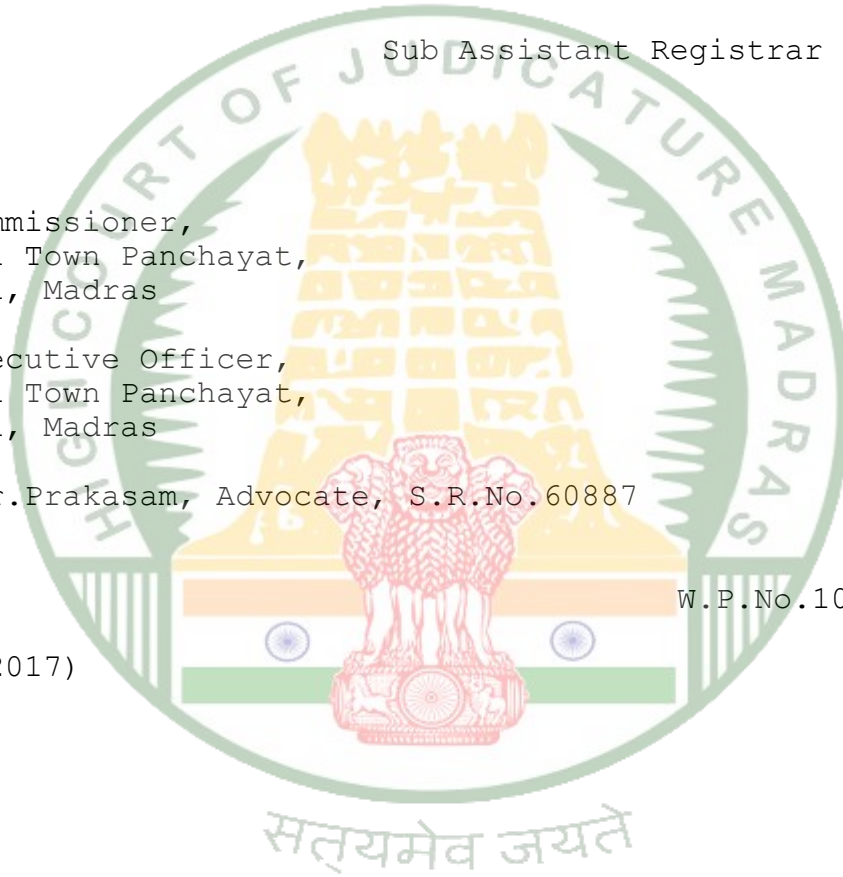
