The prosecution has examined 9 witnesses and evidence was closed and Section 313 Cr.P.C proceedings also completed and further the matter is posted on 18.07.2017 for arguments. Thus the present original petitions has become infructuous as nothing

survives in this petition. Accordingly this criminal original petition is dismissed as infructuous. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition is also closed.
