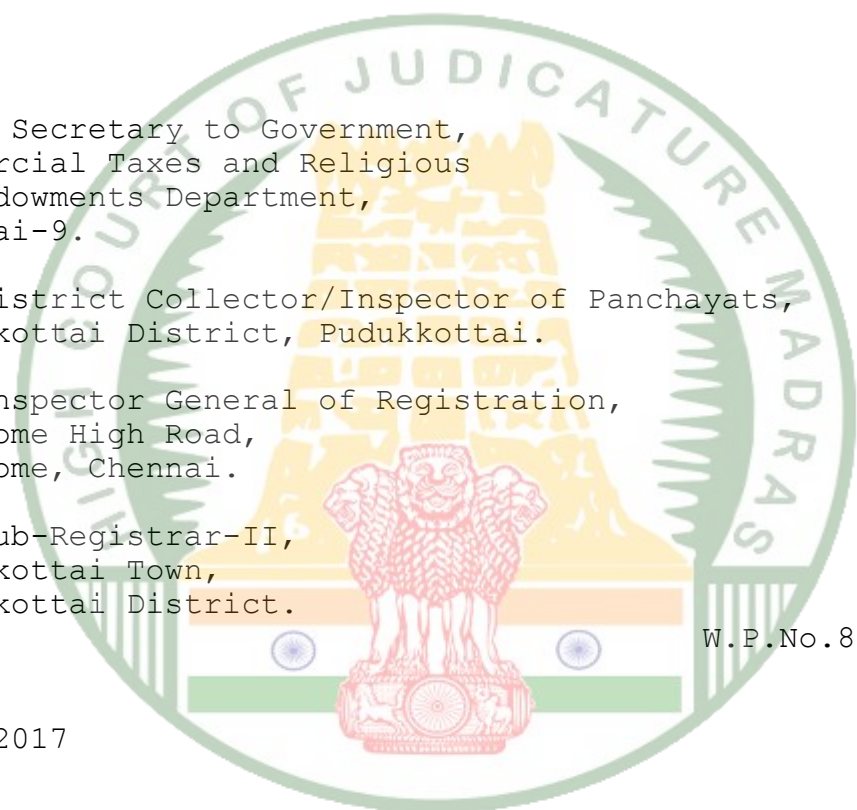

The seal of the High Court of Madras is a circular emblem. It features a central image of the Lion Capital of Ashoka, which is a four-lion capital carved from a single block of dark soapstone.
