2.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor would submit that the order of detention passed by the second respondent as against the son of the petitioner dated 25.07.2016 has been revoked by the Government in G.O. [Rt] No.4856 Home, Prohibition & Excise [X] Department dated 06.10.2016 and he has also produced a copy of the

said order.

3. Recording the submission of the learned Additional Public Prosecutor, this petition is closed as the same has become infructuous.
