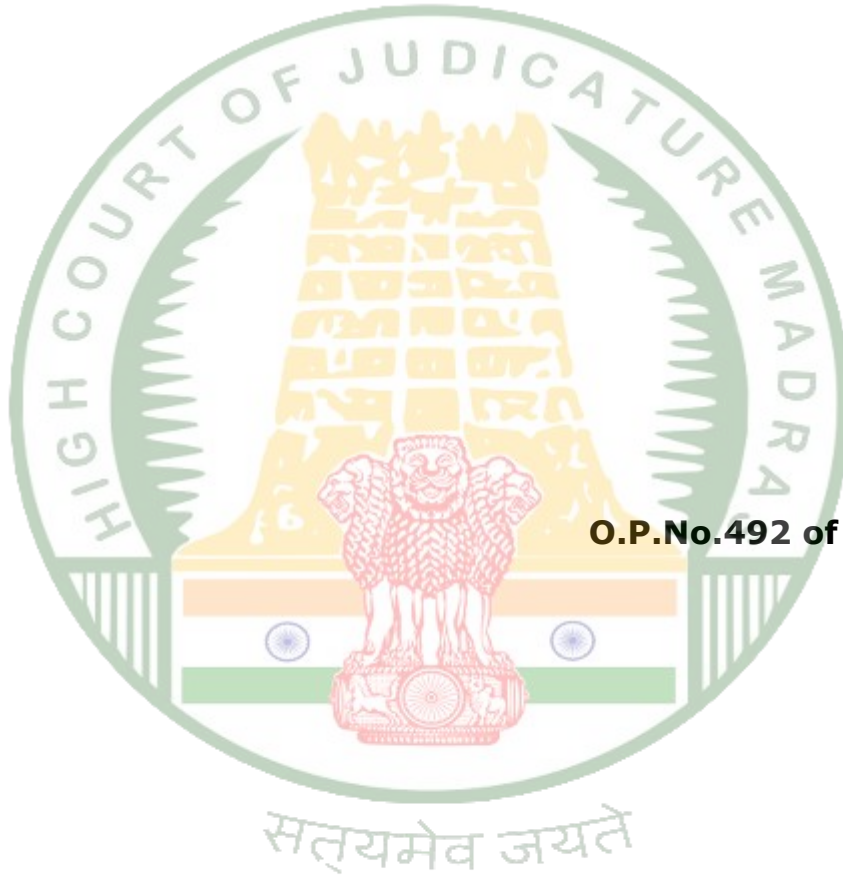
4.Recording the statement made by the learned counsel appearing for the first respondent that the award will never be executed, this original petition stands closed. No costs.
