Today, when the matter has been taken up, the learned Additional Public Prosecutor produced the statement of the petitioner, the father of the girl and the connected records pertaining to the enquiry held in the Police Station. During the enquiry, the petitioner has stated that he would not disturb the detinue and the marriage between the petitioner and the detinue has also not been admitted.

3. In view of the above, the relief, sought for by the petitioner, cannot be granted. Hence the habeas corpus petition is dismissed.
