Alleging that his daughter, by name Ms.Nandhini aged 14 years has been found missing from 27.11.2016 onwards, the petitioner has come up with this Habeas Corpus Petition.

2.Today, when the matter was taken up for hearing, the petitioner made appearance and the respondent Police has also made appearance. The Inspector of police has stated that the detainee was all along at the house of her Aunt in Andhra Pradesh and she returned home, on her own. He would further submit that no offence whatsoever was committed against her. He would further submit that in fact, the detainee was produced before the District Child Welfare Committee and the said Committee has also passed order in this regard. The said statement is recorded.

3.In view of the above, this Habeas Corpus Petition is dismissed as infructuous.

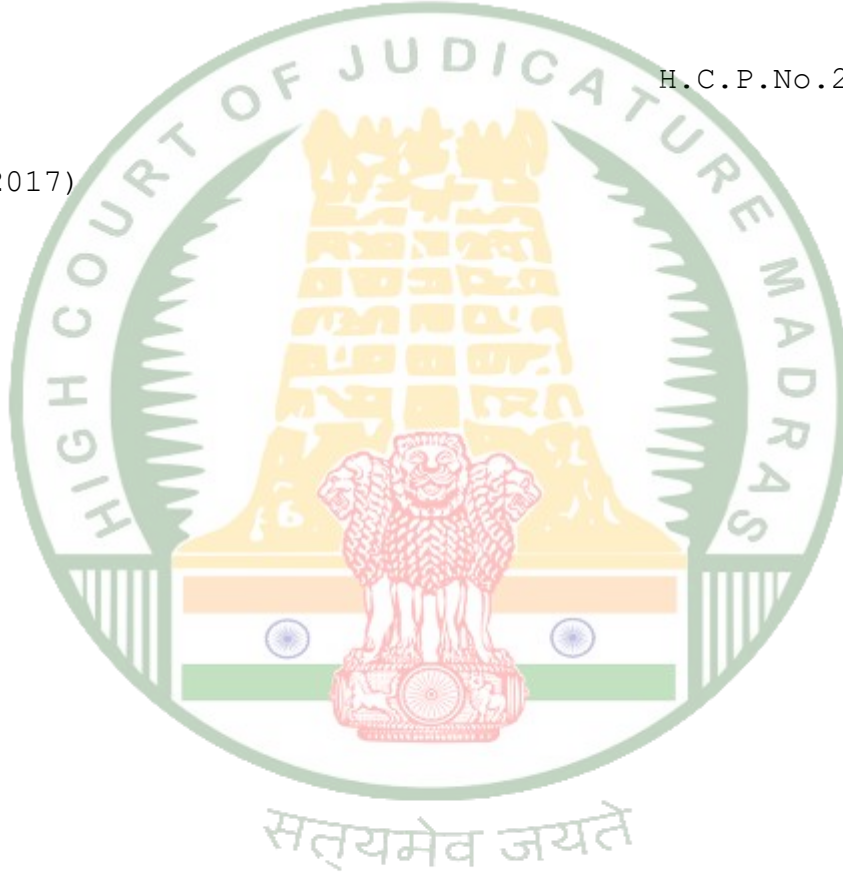
