3. In view of this piece of information, we are of the opinion that the cause in this writ petition does not survive and accordingly, the writ petition stands dismissed.

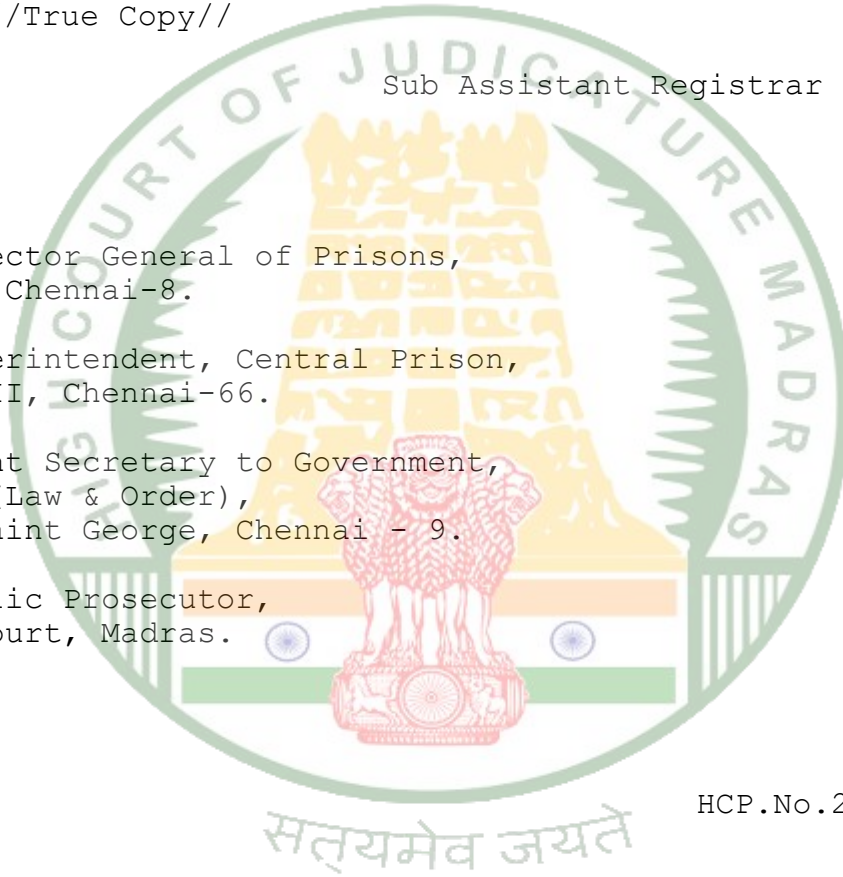
