Challenge is made to the order of detention passed by the second respondent vide Proceedings in No.387/BCDFGISSSV/2016, dated 02.04.2016, whereby the detainee, namely Parveen Taj, daughter of Mohammed Ishaq, aged about 26 years, was detained under Goondas Act and confined at Central Prison, Puzhal, Chennai.

The learned Additional Public Prosecutor would submit that the order of detention passed by the second respondent as against the petitioner dated 02.04.2016 has been revoked by the Government vide G.O. Lr. No.4709, Home, Prohibition & Excise (XIII) Department, dated 13.04.2016, and he has also produced a copy of the said order.

3. Recording the submission of the learned Additional Public Prosecutor, this Habeas Corpus Petition is dismissed as infructuous.
