2.Today, when the matter was taken up for hearing, Mrs.S.Sathikumari was produced before this Court by the respondent Police. The detainee has stated that, she went out of

the matrimonial home, on her own accord and now, she has returned. The said statement is recorded.

3.In view of the above, nothing survives in the petition and accordingly, the Habeas Corpus Petition is closed.

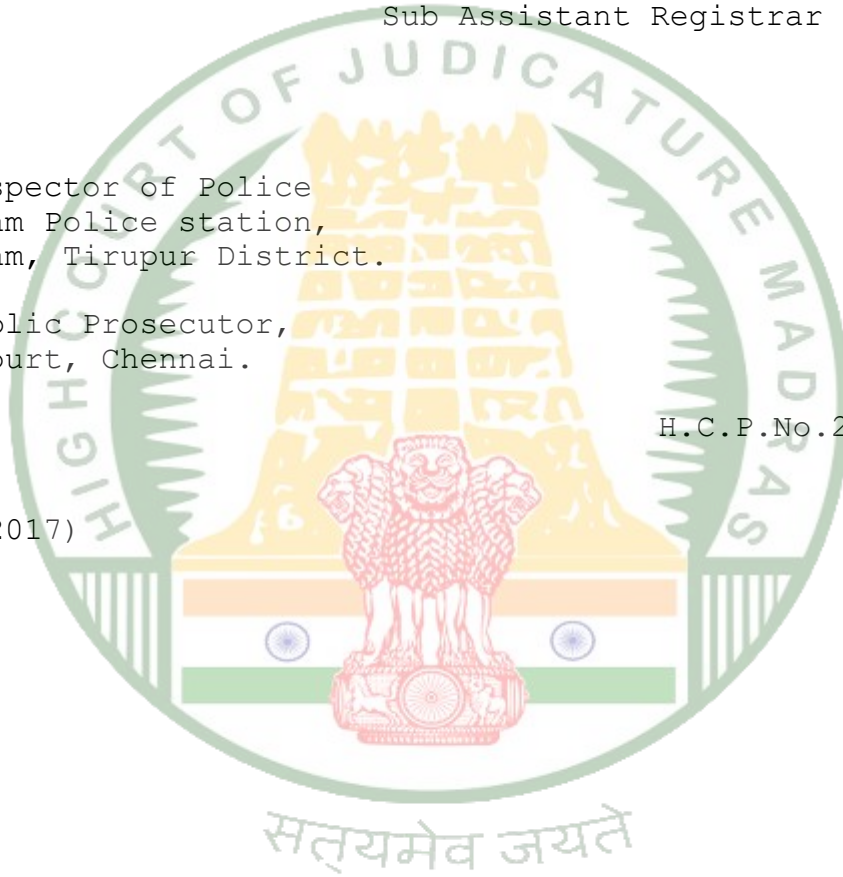
