The petitioner has challenged the Goods Detention Notice, issued by the Deputy Commissioner of Customs, the third respondent.

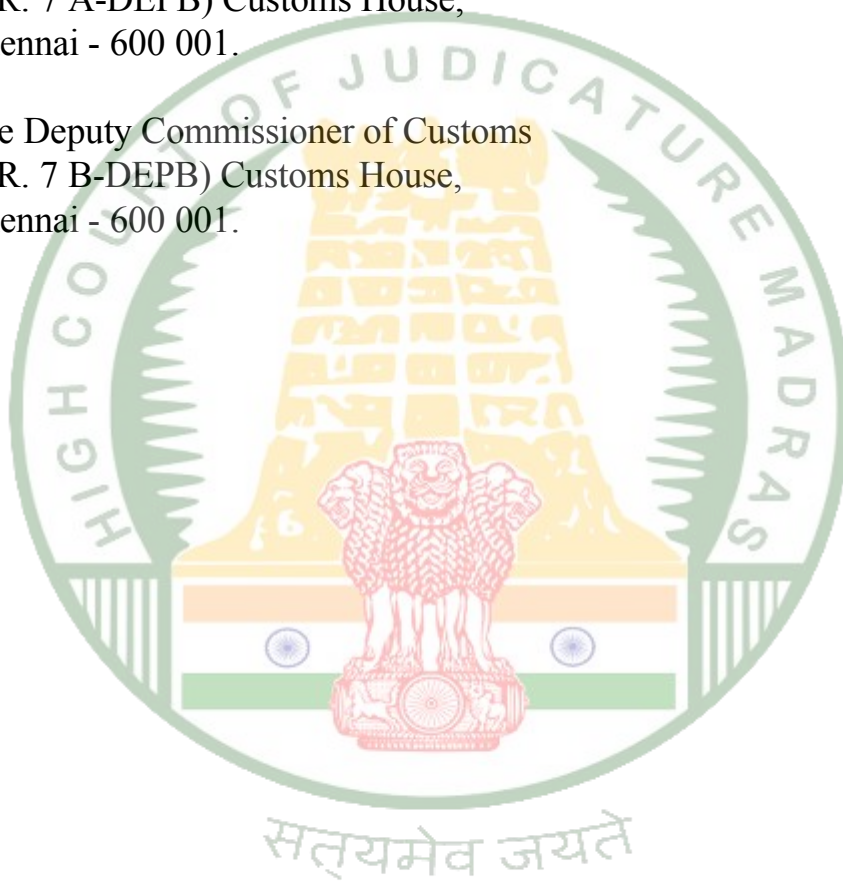
