3 In view of the submission made by the learned counsel for the petitioner and in view of the subsequent development, nothing survives for further adjudication in this writ petition and accordingly, the same is closed. The interim order granted by this Court in MP.No.1/2012 is vacated and the said miscellaneous petition is closed.

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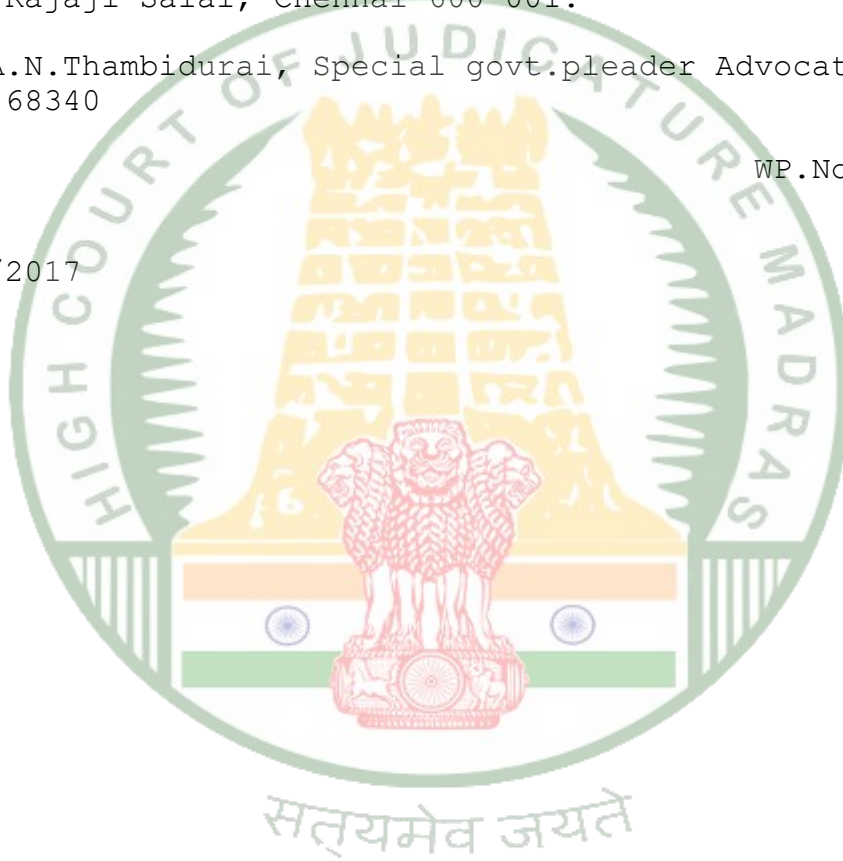
