Today, when the matter is taken up for hearing, the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that relief sought for in this Writ Petition has become infructuous for the reason that requirement of the petitioner for belated payment of retirement benefits namely Gratuity, commutation of pension, special Provident fund, encashment of earned and unearned leave due to the petitioner has been negatived in the order 08.06.2016, and it is also put to challenge in W.P.No.5902 of 2017 and the same is pending.

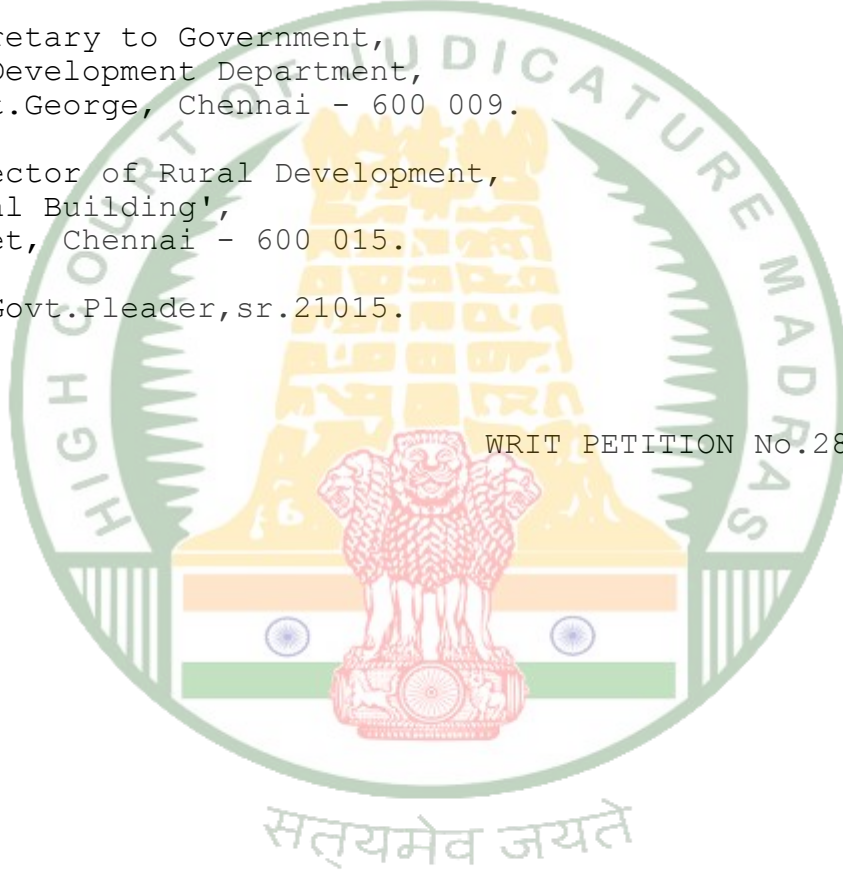
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
