PRAYER: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of The Constitution of India praying to issue a writ of Mandamus directing the respondents to pay all the pensionary benefits due and admissible to the petitioner under the rules including full pension gratuity, leave salary, regularization of the suspension period, together with interest on the belated payments and grant promotional benefits as per seniority and all other attendant benefits.

O R D E R

The relief sought for in this writ petition is to direct the respondents to pay all the pensionary benefits as admissible to the petitioner.

2. The learned Additional Government pleader appearing for the respondents filed a counter on behalf of the second respondent wherein in paragraphs 12 and 13 of the counter affidavit, it is stated that the pensionary benefits due to the writ petitioner has been settled.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner states that the pensionary dues have been paid and interest for the belated payments has not yet been settled by the respondent. However, it is a separate issue to be adjudicated by the writ petitioner by submitting a proper representation before the

competent authority in accordance with the rules in force.

4. In respect of the pensionary benefits, the same has been already settled and therefore, no further adjudication is required in this writ petition.

5. Accordingly, this writ petition stands closed. However, there shall be no order as to costs.
