O R D E R

Heard M/s.N.Mala, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner, Mr.S.Diwakar, learned Special Government Pleader, appearing for the first respondent, Mr.Benjamin George, learned counsel for the respondents 2 and 3 and Mr.M.Varun Kumar, learned counsel appearing for the respondents 4 to 7.

2.It is agreed by all the learned counsels that the matter may be referred to the first respondent, who can exercise power under Section 10 r/w. 16 of the Indian Telegraphic Act.

3.In such view of the matter, the objection of the petitioner is referred to the first respondent. The other respondents also to whom the petitioner has raised the objection shall refer the same to the first respondent. On receipt of the aforesaid, the first respondent shall conduct an enquiry and conclude it within a period of six weeks thereafter, after due notice to the parties concerned.

4.With the above direction, the writ petition is disposed of. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition is closed.
