Petition filed under Article 226 of The Constitution of India praying to issue a writ of certiorarified mandamus, to call for the records in pursuant to the impugned order of suspension issued by the first respondent in G.O.(3D) No.2 Highways Department dated 14.01.1999 and the consequential order issued in G.O.(3D) No.5 Highways Department dated 29.01.1999 and quash these orders and consequently direct the respondents to allow the petitioner to retire from service with effect from 31.01.1999 and pay all the pensionary and other monetary benefits with interest.

ORDER

The petitioner filed the writ petition challenging the suspension order dated 14.01.1999 and the consequential order dated 29.01.1999, wherein the petitioner was not permitted to retire from service.

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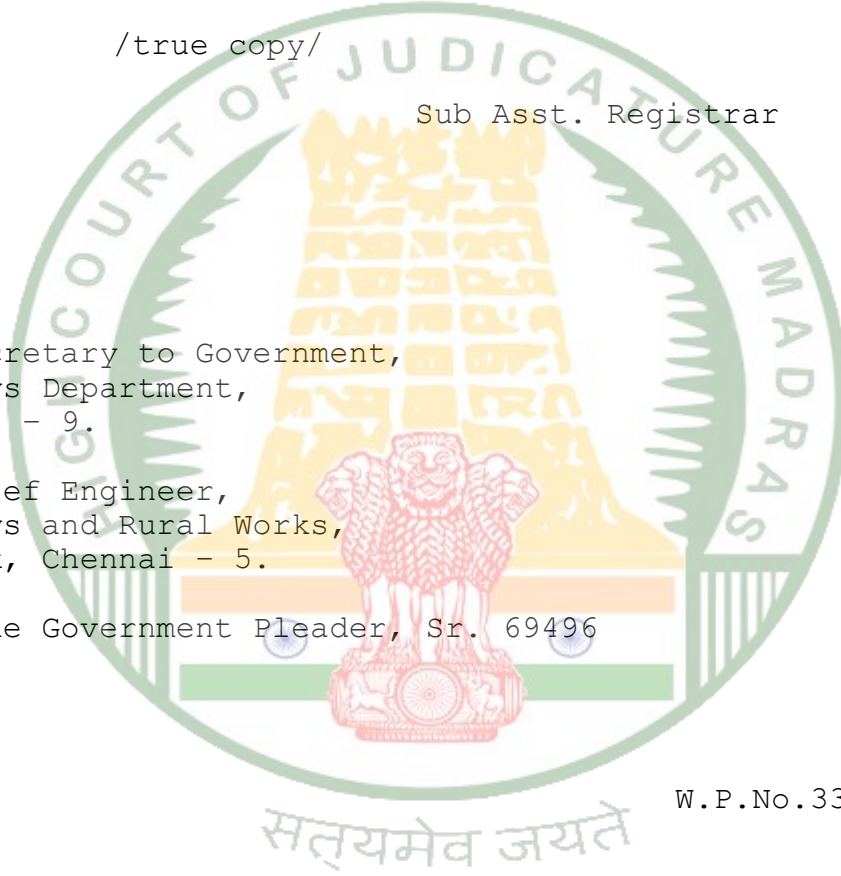
