2.The writ petitioner has submitted a representation in relation to her compassionate appointment based on the fact that her father was relieved from service on medical invalidation. 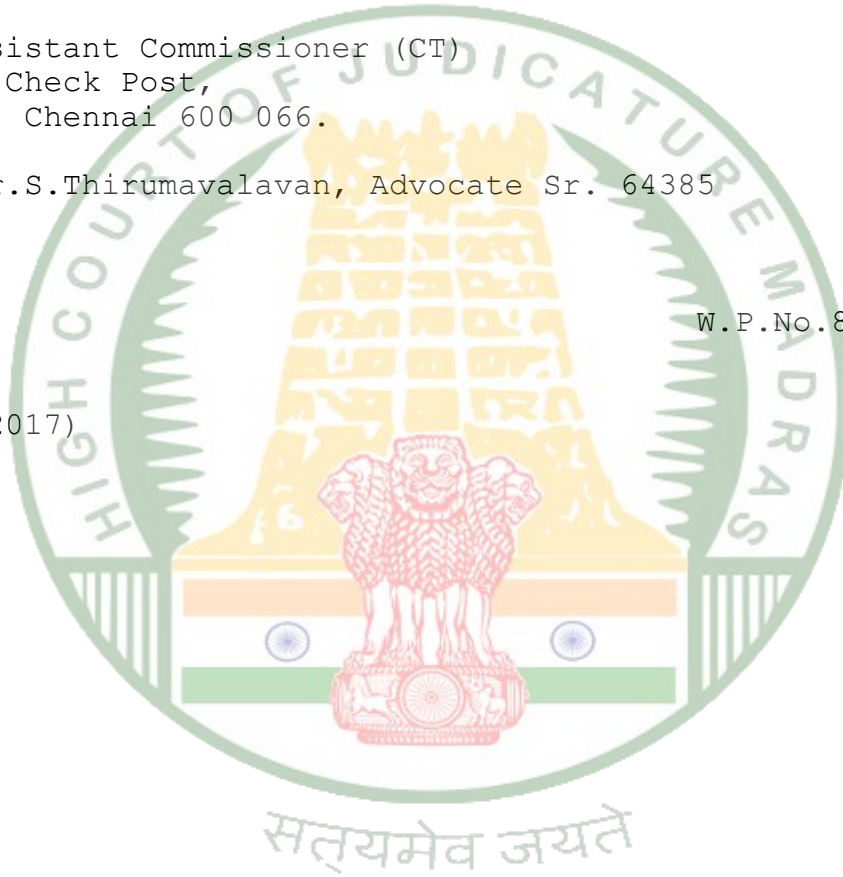
